

Teen girls 14 yrs. and older accompanied by an adult are welcome to share in the Joy.





Eucharistic Miracle of **BOLSENA**

ITALY, 1264

In 1263 a German priest, Peter of Prague, stopped at Bolsena while on a pilgrimage to Rome. He was celebrating Mass in the Basilica of Bolsena, and when the moment of consecration arrived, the Host was transformed into Flesh. This miracle strengthened the wavering belief of the priest in the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist. The Sacred Body was inspected by Urban Pope IV and by St. Thomas Aquinas. This miracle helped convince the Pope to extend the feast of Corpus Christi to the universal Church so that everyone could recognize the love God has for those who love and worship him.



Assumption of the Blessed Virgin



Holy Day of Obligation
August 15, 2025
8:15am & 7:00pm

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary refers to the event where Mary, the Mother of God, was taken up body and soul into heavenly glory at the end of her earthly life. This dogma, defined by Pope Pius XII in 1950, affirms that Mary, like her Son Jesus Christ, overcame death and is already triumphant in heaven in the fullness of her being. The Church believes that Mary's Assumption is a sign of hope for all believers, prefiguring the resurrection of the body promised to all Christians.


