



CONFIRMATION

DO YOU DESIRE A DEEPER OUTPOURING OF THE HOLY SPIRIT FOR YOUR CHILD?

Thank you for your interest in your child receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation! The Church teaches us that “by the sacrament of Confirmation, [the baptized] are more perfectly bound to the Church and are enriched with a special strength of the Holy Spirit. Hence they are, as true witnesses of Christ, more strictly obliged to spread and defend the faith by word and deed.” (Catechism of the Catholic Church, 1285)

Your family’s experience as your child walks through preparation for Confirmation includes the following:

- ✓ Child attending small groups sessions to build friendship and be formed in the Catholic faith
- ✓ Parent sessions to grow deeper in the faith to better raise their children in the Catholic faith
- ✓ Separate retreats for children and parents to experience an encounter with God
- ✓ Other formative experiences specific to Confirmation preparation



Eucharistic Miracle of
SAINT CLARE OF ASSISI



ITALY, 1240

The History of Saint Clare, Virgin, tells of various miracles performed by Saint Clare. There are episodes of multiplications of loaves, of bottles of oil that appeared in the convent when there was none before. But Clare performed the most famous of the miracles in 1240, on a Friday in September, in which she turned away an attack by Saracen soldiers who had broken into the convent cloister by showing them the Sacred Host.


