

OUR 2025 MISSION COOPERATIVE APPEAL

This year, through the Propagation of the Faith Office of our Archdiocese, our parish is blessed to welcome the Diocese of Kumbakonam, India to share in the Mission Cooperative Appeal. Rev. M. S. Selva Raj will speak with us about this mission effort the weekend of September 27-28.

The Diocese of Kumbakonam, founded in 1899 in the state of Tamil Nadu, serves 213,000 Catholics (about 6% of the local population) across 94 parishes and 610 missions. The faithful are cared for by 224 diocesan priests, 79 religious priests, 620 nuns, and hundreds of catechists. Despite their deep faith and abundant vocations, most of the Catholic population lives in poverty, and the diocese relies heavily on outside support.

Current Mission Needs Include:

- New Parishes: Establishing 8 new parishes (church and rectory) so large mission communities can receive consistent pastoral care.
- Education: Supporting 136 Catholic schools and 22 orphanages with improved facilities, teaching tools, and catechetical resources to provide faith formation and quality education for Catholic and non-Catholic children.
- Formation & Training: Offering seminars and ongoing education for 480 nuns and nearly 5,000 Catholic teachers serving in catechetical, medical, and social ministries.
- Health Care & Outreach: Sustaining diocesan hospitals, clinics, and homes that serve lepers, children of HIV patients, and children with hearing impairments.
- Seminarian Education: Supporting vocations to the priesthood and religious life, so priests and religious may also serve as missionaries abroad.
- Care for Children in Need: Providing food, shelter, and education for 4,800 orphaned or very poor children, many from families of widows, single mothers, or abusive homes—rescuing them from child labor and giving them hope for a better future.

The diocese depends on Mission Cooperative Appeal funds for nearly 80% of its projects—pastoral, educational, medical, and social outreach ministries. Your generosity makes a real difference in the lives of the poor, the marginalized, and those striving to grow in faith.

Eucharistic Miracle of

CHIRATTAKONAM



ARCHDIOCESE OF TRIVANDRUM INDIA MAY 5, 2001

This Eucharistic miracle was verified recently, on May 5, 2001 in Trivandrum, India. In the Host there appeared the likeness of a man similar to that of Christ crowned with thorns. His Beatitude Cyril Mar Baselice, Archbishop of the diocese of Trivandrum, wrote regarding this prodigy: “[...] For us believers what we have seen is something that we have always believed [...]. If our Lord is speaking to us by giving us this sign, it certainly needs a response from us”. The monstrance containing the miraculous Host is to this day kept in the church.


