

Last week we explored the many ways we can pray the rosary and how its versatility is part of what makes it such an effective form of prayer. Praying the rosary, again, is *not* about

the particular prayers but, rather, about the mysteries of the rosary. It is about allowing us to contemplate the depth and meaning of God's love through his saving actions in our history. The rosary helps to remind us to focus on the reality that God has acted and continues to act in our lives. As we delve into the meaning of any particular mystery, we can juxtapose what God has done in human history against what God is doing in our lives now. Because salvation history is not yet finished, God continues to call and renew his people with his love, to know the life that He intends for them. The rosary finds its potency in its ability to meet us where we're at, and to lead us to where God wants us to be. Let us now address how the rosary is structured and praved.

There are four sets of five mysteries each. They are:

### <u>Joyful: prayed on Mondays and Saturdays</u>

- 1. Annunciation
- 2. Visitation
- 3. Nativity
- 4. Presentation of Jesus in the Temple
- 5. Finding of the Christ Child

### Sorrowful: prayed on Tuesdays and Fridays

- 1. Agony in the Garden
- 2. Scourging
- 3. Crowning with Thorns
- 4. Carrying of the Cross
- 5. Crucifixion

### Glorious: prayed on Wednesdays and Sundays

- 1. Resurrection
- 2. Ascension
- 3. Pentecost
- 4. Assumption of Mary
- 5. Crowning of Mary as Queen of Heaven and Earth

### <u>Luminous: prayer on Thursdays</u>


- 1. Baptism of Jesus at the Jordan
- 2. Wedding at Cana
- 3. Proclamation of the Kingdom
- 4. Transfiguration
- 5. Institution of the Eucharist

Choose the mysteries you are going to pray and contemplate them. Then determine how you want to focus on those mysteries.

Begin with the Sign of the Cross.

Pray the Apostles Creed, the Our Father, three Hail Mary's (for an increase in faith, hope and charity), the Glory Be, the Fatima Prayer, and the Prayer for the Unborn.

Announce the mystery, such as "Agony in the Garden." Take a moment or two to simply listen to



what the mystery has to say to you. The Rosary is not intended to be rushed through but rather, to be savored. It is about appreciating the meaning and listening to what God might be saying to you. Then recite the Our Father and 10 Hail Mary's followed by the Glory Be, the Fatima Prayer and the Prayer for the Unborn. As you say these prayers, remember to not overly focus on the prayers themselves. Use the prayers to block out the extraneous and continue contemplating the mystery. The rosary beads are intended to help this to happen. It helps to keep the count.

Repeat the above formula for each of the remaining mysteries.

After the fifth mystery is prayed, finish with the Hail Holy Queen and the Rosary Prayer. Some people also add prayers for the intentions of the Holy Father and the Saint Michael Prayer.

Finish with the Sign of the Cross.


The prayers themselves follow on the next page for those who might like to have them all together.

# Prayers of the Holy Rosary

### Apostle's Creed

I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Creator of Heaven and earth; and in Jesus Christ, His only Son Our Lord, Who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended into Hell; on the third day He rose again from the dead; He ascended into Heaven and sits at the right hand of God, the Father Almighty; from thence He shall come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Catholic

Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body and life everlasting. Amen.

### Our Father

Our Father, Who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, on earth as it is in Heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen.

### **Glory Be**

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit. As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

### <u>Fatima Prayer</u>

O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell, lead all souls to heaven, especially those who are in most need of Thy mercy.

### Prayer for the Unborn

Jesus, protect and save the unborn.

### Hail Holy Queen (or Salve Regina may be sung)

Hail, Holy Queen, mother of mercy, our life, our sweetness, and our hope. To thee do we cry, poor banished children of Eve. To thee do we send up our sighs mourning and weeping in this valley of tears. Turn then, most gracious advocate, thine eyes of mercy toward us, and after this, our exile, show unto us the blessed fruit of thy womb, Jesus. O clement, O loving, O sweet Virgin Mary. Pray for us, O Holy Mother of God

(Response) That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

### Rosary Prayer

Let us pray. O God, whose only begotten Son, by his life, death, and resurrection, has purchased for us the rewards of eternal salvation, grant, we beseech Thee, that while meditating on these mysteries of the most holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary, we may both imitate what they contain and obtain what they promise, through Christ our Lord. Amen.

### Prayer of Saint Michael

St. Michael the Archangel, defend us in battle. Be our defense against the wickedness and snares of the Devil. May God rebuke him, we humbly pray, and do thou, O Prince of the heavenly hosts, by the power of God, cast into hell Satan, and all the evil spirits, who prowl about the world seeking the ruin of souls. 
