SUMMARY

- As you can see, the Offertory is the primary source of our income and is needed to sustain our parish and it's ministries.
- Our actual Offertory for the 1st quarter plus the month of October was a total of \$137,145, an average of \$8,067 per week. Therefore, in order to reach the Offertory's estimated goal for the year, we will have to average \$10,000 per week (34 weeks) beginning in November.
- Please consider using WeShare online giving to make your Offertory donations. This is a very convenient and secure option and helps our parish with cash flow. During this pandemic, over 50% of the Offertory has been received from WeShare giving.
- We have set our Grand Annual goal at \$60,000. Last year we received \$50,695. These donations are very helpful to our parish. A gift of any amount will make a difference and is greatly appreciated.
- We are estimating our Contribution/Gifts, which are unrestricted donations, to be \$12,000. Last year we received over \$16,000. These gifts greatly help with our operating expenses and we thank you for your generosity.
- We have also reduced our budgeted expenses for FYE 2021 by over \$113,000 compared to last year's actuals. This is
 mainly due to the elimination of some staff positions, related staff benefits, office expenses, and other operating
 expenses. Also, with Bingo being cancelled due to the pandemic, proceeds and therefore the related expenses, have
 been reduced.
- This has been a challenging year for many, especially during this COVID-19 pandemic, and we thank you for your continued, consistent generosity during these unprecedented times.
