"Of its own accord the land yields fruit, first the blade, then the ear, then the full grain in the ear." (Mark 4:28)

Reflecting on this passage, Mary Healey writes: "The sower liberally scatters his seed, then goes on with the routine of his daily life. Slowly, imperceptibly, the seed begins to sprout. The farmer does not know how this happens; even today, with the tremendous advances in microbiology, life remains a mystery. Nor can the farmer control the process...... the farmer can water, weed, and fertilize the ground as the months go on, but he cannot make the ripe grain appear a day before its appointed time."

To realize that it is ultimately God who brings growth is truly humbling. It removes human desire for domination, control, and results. It draws us to become "good and faithful" (Mt 25:23) stewards of the gifts that God has given us. Importantly, it allows God to be the God that God wants to be in our life. We cooperate with God, and we don't remain passive recipients.

Remember what Saint Paul says to the Corinthians: "I planted, Apollos watered, but God causes the growth. Therefore, neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is anything, but only God, who causes growth" (1 Corinthians 3: 6-7).

So let us walk with God patiently-everyday-radiating the fragrance of God everywhere we go!


