The keen among you will have noted in the Catholic Mirror that in addition to the new parish assignments, I have also been appointed the Episcopal Vicar for Divine Worship. In the Church, a "vicar" is one who assists a superior in the government of their territory. Just as Fr. Brad is the Parochial Vicar here (assisting the Pastor), so an Episcopal Vicar assists the Bishop in governing and leading the Diocese. Episcopal Vicars are either appointed for a geographic territory OR over specific areas of canonical competence. Bishop Joensen has appointed four Vicars Episcopal to serve our Diocese. In my case, I assist the Bishop in governing anything to do with sacraments, liturgy, rituals, and theology. This encompasses the duties I already had at the Chancery and adds a few more. Would you say a prayer for me as I assume this new job?

Finally, please do take note of the new daily Mass times and locations which begin this week. Per Diocesan policy, all regularly scheduled Masses will be celebrated in the parish church buildings.

Again, thank you for your kindness and patience over these last few weeks! Welcome to Fr. Brad, we are glad to have you on the team!
