

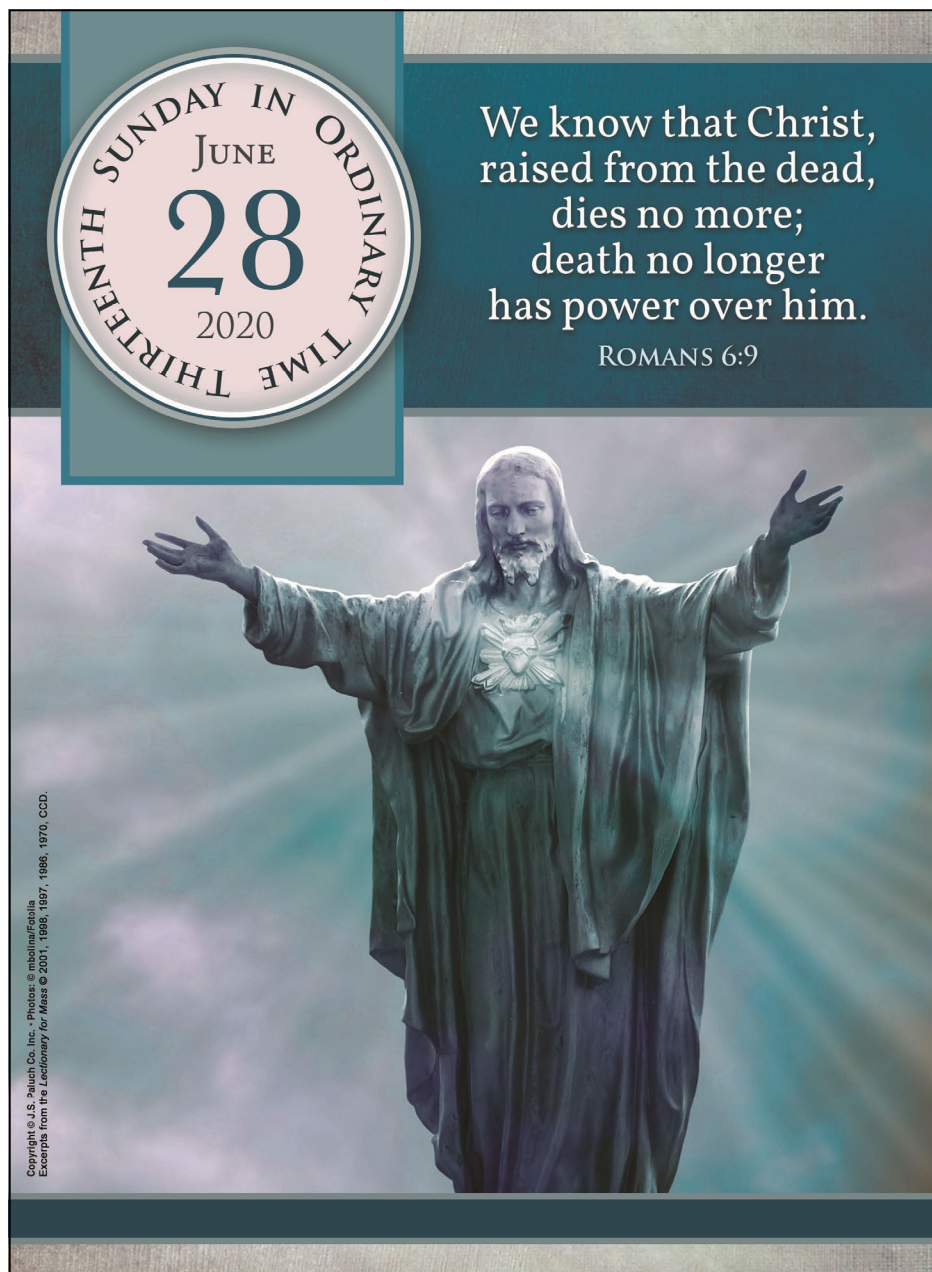

***From Father Michael Van Lian,
Burmese Community:***

**“Whoever does not take
up his cross is not worthy
of me. Whoever receives you,
receives me.”**

Matthew 10: 38-40

The Christian way of life is the cross way. The cross of Jesus is rough and tough. It means nails and a thrust of the spear. The cross calls for a sense of forsakenness and loneliness and agony and pain.

But who wants to take that road of life?

If we as Christ followers do not participate in the hardships of the cross, we are the losers.

In our gospel passage Jesus is talking about every follower of his making a sacrifice by losing his life for Christ's sake.

Sacrifices like these are unusual and exceptional. This kind of sacrifice is not a once-in-a-lifetime experience but a daily experience.

It is not a sacrifice of death but a living sacrifice that goes on from day to day. It means a daily outpouring of one's self in the cause of Christ.

It calls for giving, investing, expending, and throwing away one's life for Christ and His people. Jesus says a disciple of his will not lose his reward. Could that be the reason for you and me going on this cross-road? Amen.
