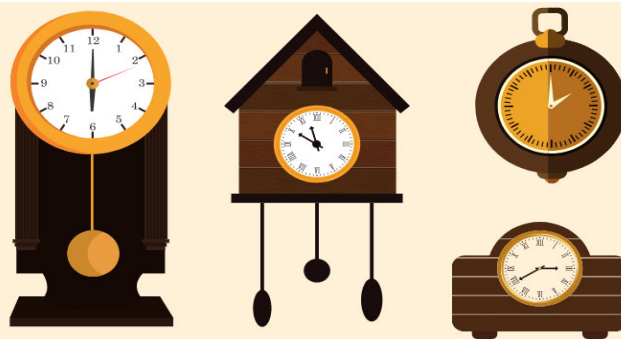
**“You shall love the Lord

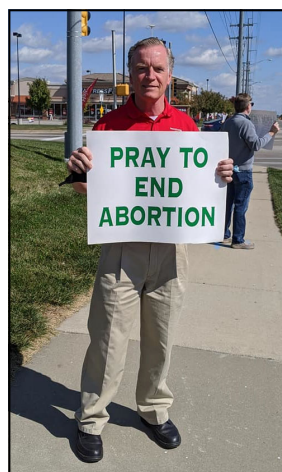

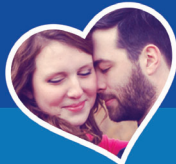
