

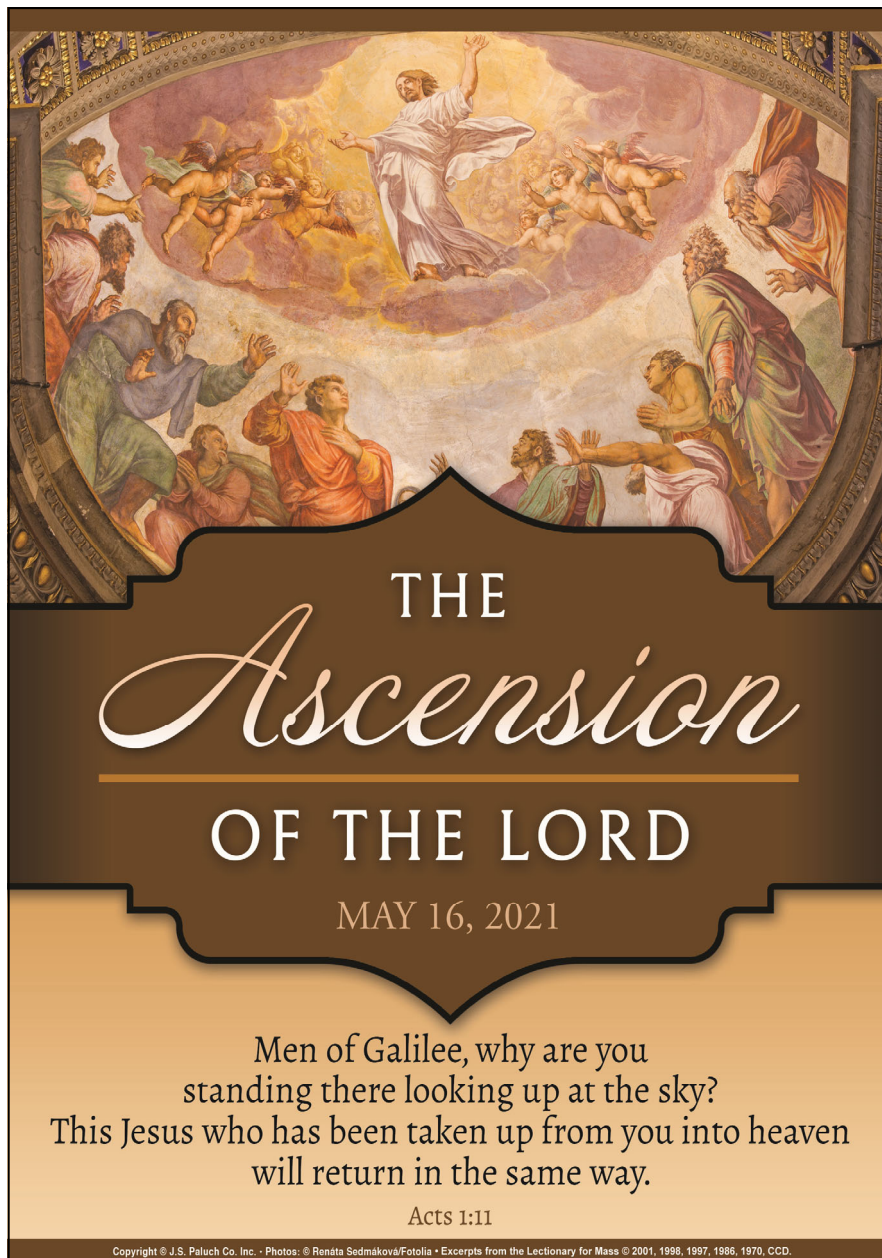

We are able to eat and have face to face conversations about all kinds of things. I don’t preach to them—this wouldn’t be wise! Rather we share our hopes, our best and worst moments and our faith experience of the ups and downs of life. I am convinced the Lord is working through us to bring healing and hope to us and to our world.

As a parish family it is also time to get back to “normal.” It is time for all who are healthy to return to regular attendance at Sunday Mass. Because of the availability of effective COVID vaccines, the rising rate of immunity and the dramatic reduction of hospitalizations and deaths related to the virus, ***Archbishop Naumann is ending the dispensation from attending Sunday mass this coming June 5-6, 2021.*** As always, infirmities resulting from age or serious health concerns dispense an individual from fulfilling the Sunday obligation. →→→

We will keep doing our best practices here at St. Patrick Parish, continuing to socially distance while masked in a well ventilated church. As summer unfolds we will evaluate our practices based on the recommendation of our Wyandotte County Health Department and the CDC.

I look forward to sharing the Eucharist with you in person and seeing how the Lord will work through each one of us!

Reporting Suspected Abuse

Archdiocese remains committed to investigating any allegation of abuse of a minor made against any member of the clergy or any church employee or volunteer—no matter the age of incident or current age of the victim. Individuals are encouraged to call confidential report line at 913-647-3051 or archkck.org/reportabuse to make a report to Jan Saylor, archdiocesan report investigator, and to call law enforcement directly. If a child or vulnerable adult is in immediate danger, call 911.

Training is required before volunteering with children at the parish or school.

Anyone over age 16 who lives in Wyandotte County can get a COVID-19 vaccine with or without an appointment. Visit WycovVaccines.org or call 3-1-1. You must have proof of residency in Wyandotte County when you come for vaccination. Teens between 16 and 17 must come with parent or guardian. Homebound persons can call 3-1-1 or fill out online transportation form at wycovvaccines.org to arrange to be vaccinated at home or transportation to and from a vaccination site.

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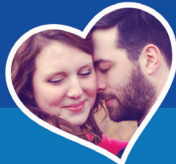
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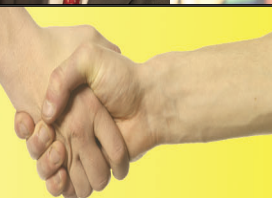
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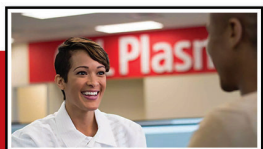
