Welcome Father Timothy Skoch, Associate Pastor!

Take Up Your Cross & Follow After Me

I try to carry with me at all times a small handheld wooden cross. This cross is a reminder to fulfill Jesus' words to us today in our Gospel: "whoever does not take up his cross and follow after me is not worthy of me." The theme of taking up one's cross can be found in all three of the Synoptic Gospels, so it is an important message. The small cross in my pocket reminds me that in difficult moments, God is offering me a chance to love Him, by imitating Jesus. The smallness also reminds me that even though this present situation might be difficult for me, in the broader scheme of things, someone else may be carrying a larger cross and accepting greater suffering.

This weekend I am reminded of the goodness of the cross and that as we seek to love God more, He will invite us into a greater share of Jesus' redemptive suffering. The cross is nothing to run from, but an invitation to greater responsibility for the Kingdom of Heaven. In fact, in the very next chapter of Matthew, Jesus will assure us: "take My yoke upon you, and learn from me...for My yoke is easy and My burden is light." Jesus promises us that if we carry our crosses with Him they suddenly bear with them a certain sweetness. If we do this, we can say with the psalmist: "forever I will sing the goodness of the Lord!"

Thank you for accepting me as your new priest. I am happy to be with you and especially excited to celebrate 150 years of the parish with you. Together may we find cause for rejoicing and blessings in abundance!

Eucharistic Amazement: Fasting Before Communion Reflection #5

How long are we required to fast before receiving Holy Communion?

Catholics are asked to fast one hour before receiving Jesus in Holy Communion. Water and medications are permissible. Gum, mints, coffee, tea, juice, food and so forth break the fast. The fast helps us to focus on the heavenly food we are about to receive—the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus in the Eucharist. It's a small sacrifice which can reap great spiritual benefits!

Desde Padre Timothy Skoch:

Toma tu cruz y sígueme

Trato de llevar conmigo en todo momento una pequeña cruz de madera en la mano. Esta cruz es un recordatorio para cumplir las palabras de Jesús para nosotros hoy en nuestro Evangelio: “el que no toma su cruz y me sigue, no es digno de mí”. El tema de tomar la propia cruz se puede encontrar en los tres evangelios sinópticos, por lo que es un mensaje importante. La pequeña cruz en mi bolsillo me recuerda que, en momentos difíciles, Dios me ofrece la oportunidad de amarlo, imitando a Jesús. La pequeñez también me recuerda que, aunque esta situación actual pueda ser difícil para mí, en el esquema más amplio de las cosas, alguien más puede estar cargando una cruz más grande y aceptando un sufrimiento mayor.

Este fin de semana recuerdo la bondad de la cruz y que a medida que buscamos amar más a Dios, Él nos invitará a una mayor participación en el sufrimiento redentor de Jesús. La cruz no es nada de que huir, sino una invitación a una mayor responsabilidad por el Reino de los Cielos.

De hecho, en el próximo capítulo de Mateo, Jesús nos asegurará: “Llevad mi yugo sobre vosotros, y aprended de mí... porque mi yugo es fácil y ligera mi carga”. Jesús nos promete que si llevamos nuestras cruces con Él, de repente llevarán consigo cierta dulzura. Si hacemos esto, podemos decir con el salmista: “¡Por siempre cantaré la bondad del Señor!”.

Gracias por aceptarme como su nuevo sacerdote. Estoy feliz de estar con ustedes y especialmente emocionado de celebrar los 150 años de la parroquia con ustedes. ¡Que juntos encontremos motivo de alegría y bendiciones en abundancia!

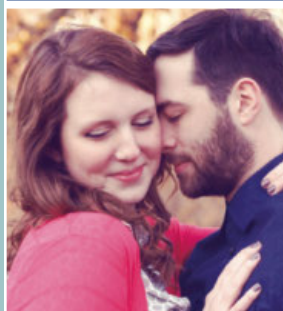

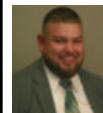
