Every year our youth and adult volunteers perform painting, repairing and rebuilding projects for the elderly and the poor. The young people learn great life lessons during this week of stewardship.

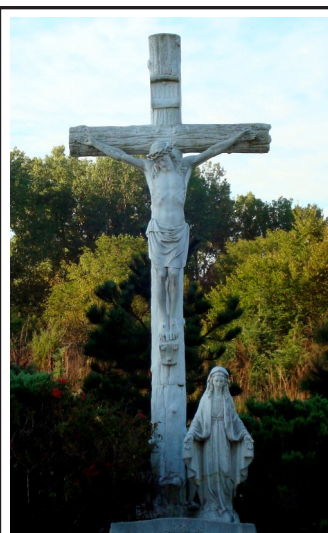

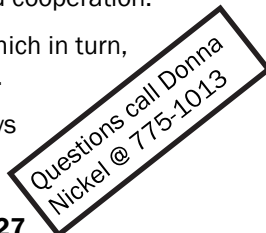
