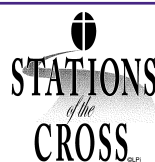
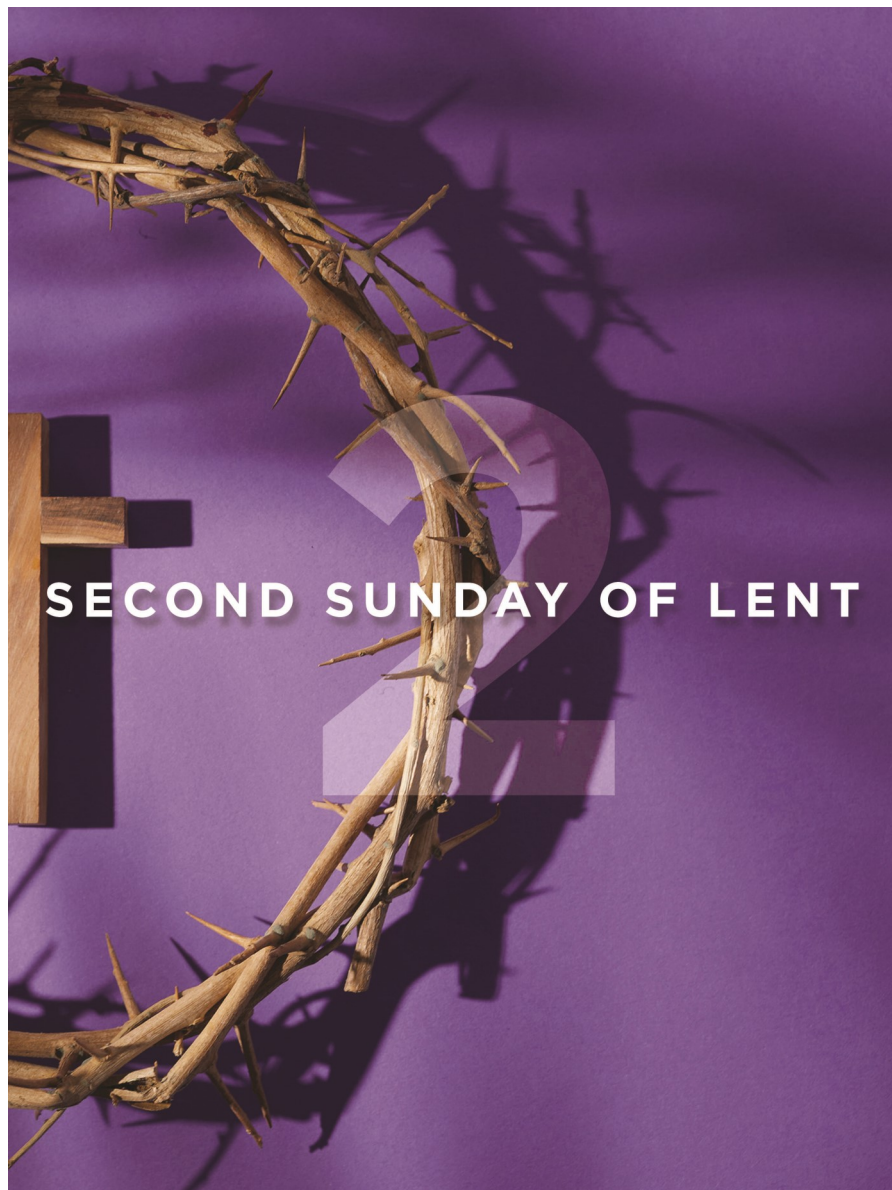

Our next meeting will be Wednesday, April 12.

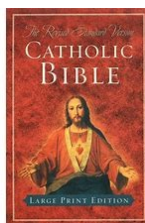


St. James' Annual Garage Sale will be June 15 - June 17. Get started
