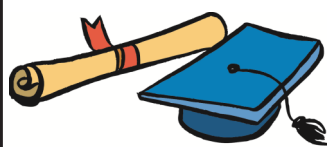

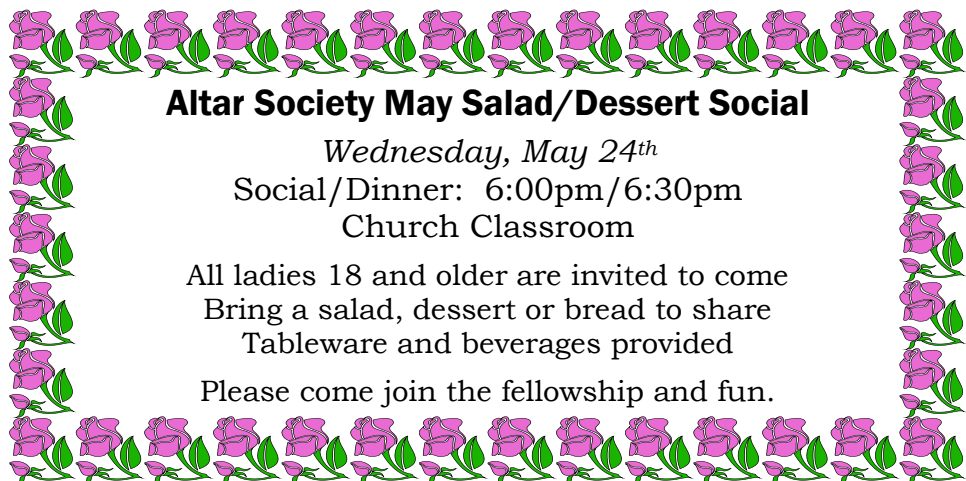
THANK YOU
