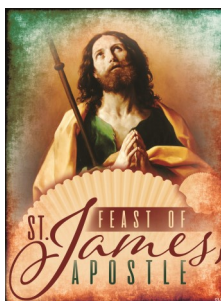


Feast of St. James the Greater Celebration July 21/22/23

Augusta Historical Theater

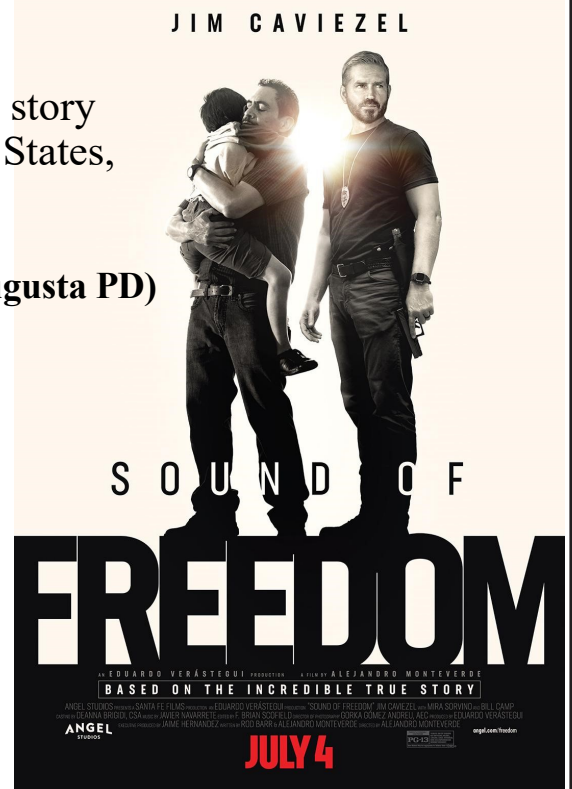
The movie Sound of Freedom, based on the true story and situation of human trafficking in the United States, is coming to the Augusta Historical Theater.

Father PJ is planning on going to the matinee on Sunday after our procession. Come join him or hit up another time!!

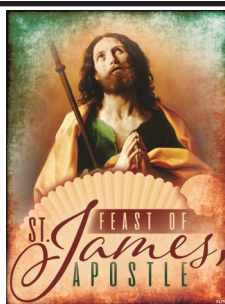

**Come have fun & fellowship!!**

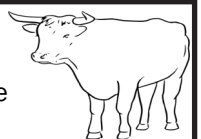
