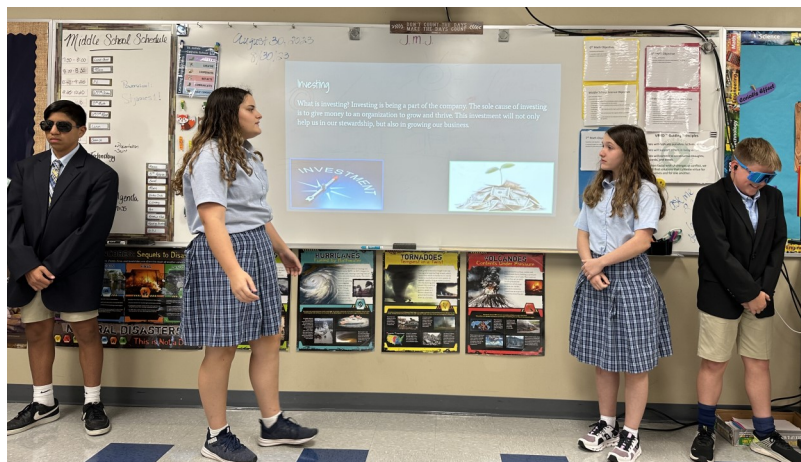


St. James Catholic School
