Dear Brothers and Sisters,

This month of Mary offers us much to reflect upon. Many people have taken this month of May to consecrate themselves to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Whatever our state in life: married, single or consecrated, we must all give our hearts to God. Here are some thoughts on Mary from Venerable Fulton Sheen, "A woman can be a virgin on one of three ways: first because she never had a chance to marry, second because she decides not to marry, third because she made a vow or a promise to God to keep herself pure for His sake although she has a hundred chances to marry.

Mary was a virgin in the third way. She fell in love at a very early age with God. Gabriel assures Mary of what Isaiah said, "A Virgin shall conceive, and bring forth a Son, and His name shall be called 'Emmanuel'. We know Mary took a vow from what she said to the angel Gabriel in exclaiming, "How can this be, seeing I know no man?" Mary was not questioning the possibility of naturally conceiving, she was questioning God about her virginal promise, which God always honors, and a virgin birth on the basis of science. The solution could only be a supernatural one.

It is through the Holy Spirit who will bring this about. Mary believes and gives consent, "Be it done unto me according to thy word". From that moment Mary takes on the vocation of all women, namely, to be to humanity the bearer of the Divine. Mary's fiat gives an acclamation of acceptance to the will of God, a faith that it will be done, and a submission of her heart, mind, soul, and body to her eternal spouse, God." Thank you, Mary, for your virginal love and commitment.

Take time this month to pray and consider the many lessons Mary's life gives us. Hers was one of total consecration to serve our Lord. How are we consecrating our life to God and finding ourselves singing, as Mary proclaims in her Magnificat, "My soul magnifies the Lord, and my spirit rejoices in God."?

Name Tag Sunday

When you arrive at church on Pentecost Sunday you will be greeted by some amazing members of our Hospitality Team who will offer you a name tag. You can opt out of this experience ... but our hope is that most people at our celebrations will decide to wear a name tag because it's important for people to know names! In John 10:3, Jesus describes the Good Shepherd as one that "...calls his own sheep by name..." How can we minister to people if we don't know their names? It's so important that we get to know each other's names. Here are four other reasons why we are celebrating Name Tag Sunday!

- Build Community There is a school of thought that says people want to be totally anonymous when they arrive at church. This thought makes it difficult for people to connect. Yes, we want to give people their space, but we want to meet them when they are ready to connect. The first step to getting connected is by allowing a nice member of our team to make up a name tag.
- It's an Invitation to Talk with other people. Our hope is that when people come to church, they will connect with the community. The goal is to get people talking to each other! People love to hear their own name ... it's the sweetest word they hear all day. By offering name tags we are encouraging many great conversations in church. What a positive emotion to associate with our church!
- Helps Me Remember Many of us are not good at remembering names but having a visual will give us a better chance of remembering someone's name next time we meet them.
- It's Not About Me Name tags are about the other people around us not ourselves. It reminds me that I'm not the center of this universe ... that I acknowledge that everyone doesn't know me ... that I'm not that big of a deal. When we put on a name tag, we are helping others who might feel uncomfortable approaching us.

Please participate by wearing a name tag and plan to join us for a coffee social after Mass on Pentecost Sunday!

Confession Heals The Soul


