The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is the process by which adult men and women become part of the Catholic Church. Through its witness, worship, service and catechesis, the whole parish community offers the invitation and support necessary for men and women to be welcomed as members of the community. Adults who are not yet baptized are accepted into the process as catechumens and prepare to receive the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist) usually during the Easter season each year. Those already baptized in another Christian tradition are welcomed as candidates for full communion and prepare to be received into the Catholic Church at a suitable time. A team of Catechists and sponsors, led by the Director of the process, journeys with the catechumens and candidates for a number of months through weekly meetings. At this time, we need catechists and sponsors to help in this process since we have four adults interested in becoming Catholic. Please contact the parish office or your pastor, Fr. Tony at tlaforet@dol.ca if you are interested in helping us welcome these candidates and catechumens into the process of becoming Catholic.

Last Sunday at St. Boniface Parish, we celebrated the return of our Youth and Family Mass. This celebration was followed by a wonderful Pancake Breakfast which was prepared by the Knights of Columbus, Council 8480. Thank you to all our parishioners who joined us for breakfast and our dedicated Knights who served us.




