Understanding Our Vision

Led by the Most. Rev. Ronald P. Fabbro, CSB, the Roman CatholicDiocese of London serves the people of God across SouthwesternOntario. Our 31 Families of Parishes covers a geographical area of 21,349square kilometers from Windsor to Woodstock, Goderich to Port Dover, and communities in between.

'Being' is the present participle of be. It is used in a continuous tense when referencing how one is currently acting or behaving.

To be mission-oriented means our eyes, hearts, and actions are set to our deepest nature:

"The Church's deepest nature is expressed in her three-fold responsibility:

- of proclaiming the word of God (kerygma-martyria),
- celebrating the sacraments (leitourgia), and
- exercising the ministry of charity (diakonia).

These duties presuppose each other and are inseparable."1

The Church is not a building or institution. We are the Church. "The Church has been seen as 'a people made one with the unity of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit."2

Forms: to bring together parts or combine to create. Faith formation is more than an education. It is a lifelong process with physical, moral, intellectual, and spiritual aspects.

A disciple is a friend and follower of Jesus. One who knows Jesus, loves Him, and shares Him with others. "Discipleship must begin with a living experience of God and his love. It is not something static, but a continuous movement towards Christ."3



Our Diocesan Pastoral Plan, *Embracing a Future Full of Hope* precedes our vision statement. However, our vision is lived out through our Pastoral Plan. While all are multi-faceted, each goal directly responds to an aspect of our vision.

Diocese of London: being a mission-oriented Church that forms disciples of Jesus.



Goal I: Personal Holiness - As living signs of Christ's presence, we will respond to the call to personal holiness given to all by committing ourselves to opportunities for ongoing conversion and spiritual renewal.

Goal II: Proclamation of the Gospel - Called by Christ, we will evangelize through the clear proclamation of the Gospel and the constant teaching of the Catholic faith, assuring that such proclamation and teaching is linked to the life experience of the people.


