ST. JOSEPH SUNDAY 11:30AM Dear Brothers and Sisters.

This is the Parable of the Spoon.......One day a man said to God, "God, I would like to know what Heaven and Hell are like. God showed the man two doors. Inside the first one, in the middle of the room, was a large round table with a large pot of stew. It smelled delicious and made the man's mouth water, but the people sitting around the table were thin and sickly. They appeared to be famished. They were holding spoons with very long handles and each found it impossible to reach into the pot of stew and take a spoonful, but because the handle was longer than their arms, they could not get the spoons back into their mouths. The man shuddered at the sight of their misery and suffering. God said, "You have seen Hell."

Behind the second door, the room appeared exactly the same. There was the large round table with the large pot of wonderful stew that made the man's mouth water. The people had the same long-handled spoons, but they were well nourished and plump, laughing and talking. The man said, "I don't understand." God smiled. "It is simple," He said, "Love only requires one skill. These people learned early to feed one another. Those who are hungry are greedy people, and they think only of themselves.

Jesus reminds us, "The Son of Man came not to be served, but to serve." (Mark 10:45) The heart of the Christian life is to serve God and one another. The Church is not healthy when it forgets this truth. We are called not just to serve individually, but to do so as a Church community or family. In this manner, we give witness that the Church is the hands and feet of Jesus in the world. In our Family of Parishes, we believe that every parishioner, without exception, has something to offer, something they do well and can do for the sake of the Kingdom of God. With this in mind we hope, like every family, every member of our family, will serve the parish by being involved in at least one ministry each year.

My friends, I invite you to look ahead and read the Parable of the Talents in Matthew's Gospel (Mt 25.14-30) which we will listen to next week. As you read this Gospel, please consider offering your gifts and talents to serve our God and His holy people, the Church. Join our Ministry Fair next week and sign-up to serve in one of our various ministries.

Finally, thank you to all our parishioners who have served and continue to serve in our parishes. Your efforts to share your time, talents and treasures have made a huge impact in the life of our parish communities!




