The Feast of Christ, the King of the Universe, which we celebrate this weekend, marks the conclusion of our Liturgical Year and the beginning of a new liturgical year. This begins next Sunday when we, the Church, God's people, celebrate the First Week of Advent.

The liturgical new year doesn't begin with fireworks and fanfare like New Year's Day, but rather, a deep and profound message to keep awake! We must be alert because something new and amazing is coming! We must be prepared for this arrival......the birth of a child who is coming to save humanity from sin and darkness. The Season of Advent is a time to prepare and reflect upon the importance of God's gift of salvation, the birth of Jesus.

It is a time for generous good works in which our kindness and care for others displace excessive self-absorption and concern. Our participation in good works, such as the simple donation of canned goods or socks for the homeless and needy, can create an open heart where there is room for Christ's powerful and essential presence.

Finally, please continue to prayerfully consider helping us grow as a family and becoming a more active member by participating in one of our many ministries in this church community. We now have six people interested in becoming members of the Catholic Church but we need a team to help and walk with them on their faith journey. Please consider becoming a part of our RCIA Team today.

May this new season of Advent fill your hearts with the anticipated joy of Christ's birth and a longing to become disciples of Jesus, our Good and Faithful Shepherd!


