Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Our Diocese is promoting vocations through a program, 'Called By Name'. We are inviting you to consider the young men in your lives, friends, or family, whom you see have qualities or gifts, anyone you think who could potentially become a good priest. They may never think about it until someone taps them on the shoulder. We are calling on you to forward their names to us so we can connect with them personally and let them know that someone thinks they might be a good candidate for the priesthood. If you have seen the movie, Father Stu, you may realize that even the most unexpected person can be called by God to be a good priest.

Who knows? I did not recognize the deep call until I was in college, studying Architecture. One day, when I was at the Seminary, I remember saying to myself, 'I am home'. I have never looked back. I am now to be 39 years a priest. My 40th Anniversary is May 4, 2025. Maybe we will whoop it up then, in thanksgiving.

Let me share a little more of my story. When I was an infant with viral pneumonia, I was set in a hospital room to die that night. I did not die, for God had a plan. On my Godmother's seeing me as an infant, she said to my mother and father that I was going to be a priest. I did not hear of this until I was already in the Seminary.

To become a priest is a calling, AND we would like to call on the names you forward to us, of those young men who by our invitation may contemplate a vocation to the priesthood.

There will be forms at the entrance of the church, please give thought to someone who would like to learn more about this blessed opportunity.

Let us pray that many young men will hear their name being called to the priesthood.


