

From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

If we are familiar with the Gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke and John and the stories they tell us about the life of Jesus, then we can be quite certain that Jesus loved eating and dining with every person he ever met. This Sunday's Gospel from Luke is no exception...

"When you hold a lunch or dinner, do not invite your friends or your brothers (and sisters) or your relatives or your wealthy neighbors, in case they may invite you back and you have repayment. Rather, when you hold a banquet, invite the poor, the crippled, the lame, the blind; blessed indeed will you be because of their inability to repay you. For you will be repaid at the resurrection of the righteous." (Luke 14. 12-14)

I can't help but hope and wonder if we have this right as we continue to invite the poor and the lonely to join us for our weekly banquet at Precious Blood Parish in Exeter (from 5:30 to 7 pm) called the Common Plate! Each week, we are seeing the numbers growing steadily as we seek to serve those in this community who need a sense of community and who hunger for nourishment. Let us keep inviting those who need this opportunity to dine with Jesus and his companions. Donations to this weekly dinner are always welcome and as always, we thank all our volunteers in the various Exeter churches for their assistance in making this possible each week!

In addition, Fishes & Loaves have been serving the needs of the poor in Goderich and at this time there may be a need to support a few families in Goderich who lost their home (apartment) in the fire that occurred two weeks ago. Is there something we can do to help? If anyone is interested in assisting them in finding a temporary or permanent solution, please contact me at your earliest convenience.

We should also be aware that there is an effort in our Family of Parishes to seek new leaders to help us organize and assist us in our efforts to build community in our Family of Parishes as we welcome new families and parishioners. Some of these new leaders may already be volunteers but we wish to acknowledge their many contributions and form them into leaders like Jesus did with the 70 he appointed!

Jesus also took every opportunity to teach his disciples and followers about His Father in Heaven and how we can learn to grow in faith and trust our Father. For several years now, our Family of Parishes has purchased a subscription to Formed but we learned this week that just over 200 families have registered and are using Formed! Please visit our website to register so you too can watch and learn all about the saints and our amazing Catholic Faith.

Fr. Anthony is working on obtaining his G2 license and is still searching for a good used vehicle. We are grateful to all those who continue to drive Fr. Anthony to his appointments and celebrations in our various parishes. It has been a great team effort!

Gospel Reflection - August 31, 2025

22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time (Year C)

Gospel: Luke 14:1, 7-14 (RSV-CE)

"For everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted." (Luke 14:11)

Jesus teaches about humility and generosity as He dines in the home of a Pharisee. He challenges us not to seek honor for ourselves but to live humbly, and to welcome those who cannot repay us. In God's Kingdom, true greatness is measured not by status but by service and hospitality to those most in need.

Reflection Questions

- Where in my life am I being called to greater humility?
- Who in my community might be the "poor, the maimed, the lame, and the blind" that Jesus asks me to welcome?
- How can I practice generosity this week without expecting anything in return?

Prayer

Lord Jesus,

You teach us that true greatness is found in humility, and that real love is shown in welcoming those who cannot repay us.

Give us hearts that do not seek honor, but that are ready to serve. Open our eyes to the poor, the lonely, and the forgotten, so that in welcoming them, we welcome You.

Make us gentle and generous, so that our lives may reflect Your Kingdom of love.

Amen.

Sunday Seeds For Children – Gospel Reflection

Jesus noticed people trying to sit in the best seats at a big meal. He told them a story to show that it's better to be humble and take the lower place. He also said that when we invite others, we should welcome those who can't pay us back—the poor, the sick, and the lonely—because that is what God's love looks like.

Think About:

- Do I sometimes want to be first or noticed more than others?
- How can I be kind to someone who might feel left out?

Try This:

This week, choose one small way to let someone else go first—like letting a friend pick the game, or giving up the best seat. Do it with love, just as Jesus taught.

Commentary

We must submit a balanced budget to the Diocese, so donations have been adjusted accordingly to cover projected expenses.

>Bad weather has significantly impacted attendance and, in turn, collections early this year. Please consider Pre-Authorized Giving, which ensures steady support even when weather affects in-person attendance. It's simple and convenient—expenses continue regardless of the weather. To set this up, contact Lori Laporte at llaporte@dol.ca or 877-450-6416 x240.

> Due to two large donations in Goderich this month (\$10,000 & \$2,500) we were able to get back on budget and reduce the year to date Deficit by \$5,636 this month. Thank you to all our donors when make our mission possible!

>Snow removal and utility costs at most churches were significantly higher than last year—what a winter! However, the land maintenance budget was spread evenly across 12 months, so this could balance out over the year.>

>The deficit at Precious Blood is a combination of Snow Removal, Utilities, Dishwasher and Automatic Door repairs and donations being down from last year and the budget. Funds are needed to eliminate the \$28,262 deficit, for the replacement of the Heating and Cooling system (~\$150,000) and the outstanding Loan amount of \$387,724 that is also straining Finances (interest payments of ~\$13,500 for the year)

>We are in urgent need of a Finance Committee member from St. Peter Parish in St. Joseph and Mount Carmel. This is a must. If you are interested, please contact Deacon Jim Van Lanen, Fr. Tony, or the Parish office.
