From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

The month of November is a time to reflect and remember!

First, we remember the Souls of the Faithful Departed on **Sunday, November 2nd (All Souls' Day)**. We recall our loved ones who have died and the promise of the Resurrection made possible through Jesus' death and resurrection.

Secondly, on **Tuesday, November 11th**, we remember our veterans who gave their lives in service to their country – those who fought for freedom and sacrificed their lives to bring peace to our world.

Finally, we remember the powerful words of our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ, who said to His disciples:

"I have come to set the earth on fire, and how I wish it were already blazing!" (Luke 12:49)

Fire is powerful! A blazing fire can purify precious metal, such as gold. When gold is heated to a liquid state, the impurities rise to the surface and can be removed. Fire also consumes. When a fire has finished its burning, only ashes remain. Many great saints have reflected upon fire as an image of the purification God desires to work within our souls.

St. John of the Cross, for example, compared entering into divine union with God to a log burning in a fire. At first, as the log begins to burn, it crackles and pops because the impurities within it – moisture or sap – resist the flames. But as the log continues to burn, it becomes one with the fire. Initially, we can distinguish the log from the flame; yet, once the entire log is engulfed and its impurities are burned away, it glows, giving off both light and heat.

When we reflect on Jesus' words about His desire to "set the earth on fire," we must understand this as His longing to purify our souls. Within each of us are impurities that must be removed if we are to become one with God, radiating His light and glory. This purification is a process – one in which God brings our sins to the surface so they can be healed and removed. But this can only happen if we allow the blazing fire of God's purifying love to consume us.

Too often, we become content with mediocrity in our faith. We pray, go to Mass on Sunday, and try to be good – but this is not the fullness of life our Lord desires for us. He wants our hearts to be radically consumed by the blazing fire of His love. He wants us to be so purified that He can live fully within us, shining forth His radiance through our lives.

Let us ponder this image of a blazing, purifying fire – the gold refined until its impurities rise to the surface, or the log that becomes one with the flame. God wants so much more for us! He desires to transform us and use us in ways beyond our imagination.

Friends, let us not be afraid to make the radical decision to allow the purifying fire of our Lord's mercy to transform us. Don't wait for tomorrow – kindle that flame today.

30th Sunday in Ordinary Time – Year C – October 26thth, 2025**Luke 18:9-14 – Pharisee & Tax Collector**

In this week's Gospel, Jesus contrasts the proud Pharisee with the humble tax collector (Luke 18:13). The Pharisee trusted in his own righteousness, but the tax collector simply prayed, "God, be merciful to me, a sinner." God looks not at appearances, but at the heart. Sirach tells us that the prayer of the humble "pierces the clouds." True discipleship begins when we let go of pride and admit our need for God's mercy.

For Reflection

1. When have I experienced the "mustard seed" of faith in my own life?

2. Do I see my service to God and others as a duty, or as a grateful response to His love?

3. How is God inviting me to trust Him more deeply in areas where I feel impatient or discouraged?
