

From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Advent awakens us not only to the birth of Christ but also to the beginning of a new year in the life of the Church. With Christ's coming, we begin anew. On the First Sunday of Advent, November 30, we will transition from Cycle C to Cycle A. This year, Cycle A focuses on the Gospel of Luke, which we will hear throughout our Mass celebrations this Advent.

Because Advent is a season of preparation, repentance, and royal expectation. The colour purple, used in our liturgies, reflects these spiritual themes as we await the coming of our true King. Because Advent is above all a season of prayer, we are providing two different prayer booklets to help individuals and families prepare their hearts for the birth of Christ.

Pope Benedict XVI reminds us, *"It is the beautiful task of Advent to awaken in all of us memories of goodness and thus to open doors of hope."*

Indeed, we are blessed to see many signs of hope in our Family of Parishes. This fall, the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) began with ten candidates from across our communities. We gather every Sunday afternoon at St. Boniface Church in Zurich, and everyone is welcome to join us. Please keep these candidates in your prayers, and consider serving as a sponsor for one of them.

We are also delighted that several students in our schools have expressed interest in becoming altar servers. We are organizing training sessions for these young people, and we ask for the support of their parents—especially in bringing their children to Sunday Mass. Please pray for these students and their families as they begin this meaningful ministry.

Finally, as we hear much about Black Friday deals and Giving Tuesday, we encourage parishioners to consider offering a gift to your parish. Some of our parishes require significant repairs or replacements of major components, and our staff is currently stretched thin. We hope to hire a Youth and Family Coordinator to help us better serve our Family of Parishes. Your generosity this Christmas season will make a real difference.

May you and your family prayerfully and patiently enjoy a blessed Advent Season.

Understanding the Christmas Season

The Christmas Season is more than just December 25—it is a beautiful stretch of time in which the Church celebrates the mystery of God becoming human and dwelling among us. Here is a simple overview of the dates and the meaning behind them.

When Does the Christmas Season Begin?

► December 24 (Evening) – Christmas Vigil

The season begins with the Vigil Mass on Christmas Eve, following the ancient tradition of a feast beginning the evening before.

Key Days of the Season

► Christmas Day – December 25

We celebrate the birth of Jesus Christ, the Light of the World.

► The Octave of Christmas – December 25 to January 1

For eight days, the Church celebrates Christmas as one continuous feast. The Octave concludes on January 1, the Solemnity of Mary, the Holy Mother of God.

► Epiphany of the Lord – Sunday between January 2–8

We celebrate Christ revealed to the nations, symbolized by the Magi.

When Does the Christmas Season End?

► Baptism of the Lord – The Sunday after Epiphany

This feast marks the end of the Christmas Season. Jesus' baptism begins His public ministry, making it the natural conclusion to the celebrations of His birth and early life.

Why These Dates?

Incarnation – God becomes man in Jesus.

Octave – The Church extends Christmas joy over eight full days.

Epiphany – Christ is revealed to the world.

Baptism of the Lord – Jesus is shown as the beloved Son and begins His mission.

Matthew 24:37-44

With Advent, a new Church year begins. Jesus tells His disciples to “stay awake” because the Son of Man will come at an unexpected hour (Matthew 24:42-44). Advent is a season of watchfulness – not fear, but hopeful expectation.

Isaiah's vision of nations streaming to the Lord's mountain (Isaiah 2:2) paints a picture of peace and unity, while St. Paul urges us to “put on the Lord Jesus Christ” (Romans 13:14). Advent is a call to wake up from distractions, to walk in the light of Christ, and to prepare our hearts for His coming – both at Christmas and at the end of time.

For Reflection



1. How can I live Advent as a season of watchful preparation rather than rushing through it?
2. What distractions keep me from “staying awake” to God's presence?
3. How can I put on the light of Christ in a practical way this week?

Sunday Seeds



Advent is the time to get ready for Jesus. He tells us to “stay awake” and be ready for Him to come. Advent is not just about presents but about preparing our hearts.

- **Try this...** Help light the Advent wreath this week, and each time you see the candle, say: “Jesus, I'm ready for You.”



Laudato Si': Chapter Four - Integral Ecology

This month we explore Laudato Si' Chapter 4: **Integral Ecology**.

After exploring the roots of the ecological crisis, Pope Francis turns attention to promoting a way forward as we address the crisis.

He notes that since everything is interconnected, we must consider a way forward through multiple interconnected lenses.
