On June 19, the Solemnity the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, the Catholic Church in the US will begin a multi-year Eucharistic Revival (<https://www.davenportdiocese.org/liturgy/eucharistic-revival>), hoping to “renew the Church by enkindling a living relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist.” Our diocese will open this first year of the Revival with Mass at Sacred Heart Cathedral followed by a Eucharist Procession to St. Anthony’s Church (0.8 mi). Mass will begin at 3pm. If you are interested in taking part please let the parish office know by Tuesday, June 14, since seating is limited. Also please know:

- We are asking that each individual or household bring a loaf of sliced sandwich bread (wheat or white) to donate to hunger ministries in the neighborhood. As the Catechism reminds us, “The Eucharist commits us to the poor” (#1397).
- Bring walking shoes and a water bottle. The sidewalks may be uneven, so please take extra care – especially if you have gait or balance issues. There will be rides back to the Cathedral

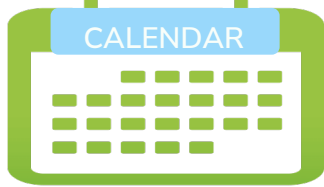

**Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity**

Each year on the first Sunday after Pentecost we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. This feast was established for universal observance in 1334 by Pope John

XXII. Also referred to as Trinity Sunday, it is a time to remember that "being Christian is not the result of an ethical choice or a lofty idea, but the encounter with an event, a person, which gives life a new horizon and decisive direction" (Deus Caritas Est 1). In revealing himself as Trinitarian, God hasn't merely shared impersonal facts *about* himself; rather, God has shared *himself* with us, and has invited us into his own inner life and communion of love, which alone is the origin, goal, and meaning of our life.

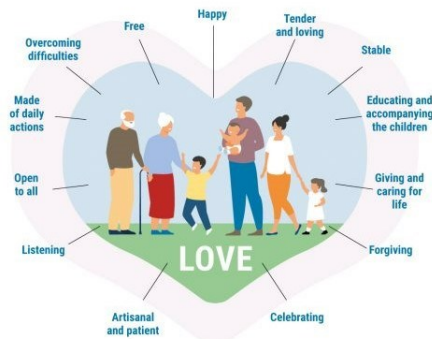
As we read in the Catechism, "By sending his only Son and the Spirit of Love in the fullness of time, God has revealed his innermost secret: God himself is an eternal exchange of love, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, and he has destined us to share in that exchange" (CCC 221). On Trinity Sunday, the Church proclaims the truth about God—that God is love (1 John 4:8)—and the truth about us: we are made for this love. By grace, we are continuously being invited to live in the love of God!

Pope Francis' June Prayer Intention

This month, the Holy Father asks the Church to pray for "Christian families around the world; may they embody and experience unconditional love and advance in holiness in their daily lives." This prayer intention coincides with the celebration of the World Meeting of Families taking place in Rome on June 22-26. Let us always remember to keep the family at the center of our lives as the family is a path of holiness. LA SANTA MISA DE HOY ES PARA LEONIDES LEZA**Felicidades y bienvenido**

El sábado 4 de junio de 2022 dimos la bienvenida a la membresía plena de nuestra Iglesia Católica a través de las aguas del Bautismo, los sacramentos de la Confirmación y la Eucaristía a 7 feligreses: Eliana Ocampo, Olivia Ocampo, Aria Ocampo, Chloe Remour, Benjamin Remour, Emiliano Salcedo y Royce Salcedo.

**Procesión Eucarística del Corpus Christi**

El 19 de junio, Solemnidad del Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo, la Iglesia Católica en los EE. UU. comenzará un Avivamiento Eucarístico de varios años (<https://www.davenportdiocese.org/liturgy/eucharistic-revival>), con la esperanza de "renueva la Iglesia encendiendo una relación viva con el Señor Jesucristo en la Sagrada Eucaristía". Nuestra diócesis abrirá este primer año del Avivamiento con una Misa en la Catedral del Sagrado Corazón seguida de una Procesión Eucarística a la Iglesia de San Antonio (0.8 millas). La misa comenzará a las 3:00 de la tarde. Si está interesado en participar, informe a la oficina parroquial antes del martes 14 de junio, ya que el cupo es limitado. También por favor sepa:

- Estamos pidiendo que cada individuo u hogar traiga una barra de pan (trigo o blanco) para donar a los ministerios contra el hambre en el vecindario. Como nos recuerda el Catecismo, "La Eucaristía nos compromete con los pobres" (#1397).
- Traiga zapatos para caminar y una botella de agua. Las aceras pueden ser irregulares, así que tenga mucho cuidado, especialmente si tiene problemas para andar o de equilibrio. Habrá paseos de regreso a la Catedral.

Solemnidad de la Santísima Trinidad

Cada año el primer domingo después de Pentecostés celebramos la Solemnidad de la Santísima Trinidad. Esta fiesta fue establecida para observancia universal en 1334 por el Papa Juan XXII. También llamado Domingo de la Trinidad, es un tiempo para recordar que "ser cristiano no es el resultado de una elección ética o de una idea elevada, sino del encuentro con un acontecimiento, una persona, que da a la vida un nuevo horizonte y una dirección decisiva". (Deus Caritas Est 1). Al revelarse a sí mismo como trinitario, Dios no solo ha compartido hechos impersonales sobre sí mismo; más bien, Dios se ha compartido con nosotros y nos ha invitado a su propia vida interior y comunión de amor, que es el único origen, meta y sentido de nuestra vida. Como leemos en el Catecismo, "Al enviar a su Hijo único y al Espíritu de Amor en la plenitud de los tiempos, Dios ha revelado su secreto más íntimo: Dios mismo es un eterno intercambio de amor, Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo, y ha nos ha destinado a participar en ese intercambio" (CIC 221). El Domingo de la Trinidad, la Iglesia proclama la verdad sobre Dios —que Dios es amor (1 Juan 4:8)— y la verdad sobre nosotros: estamos hechos para este amor. Por gracia, estamos continuamente invitados a vivir en el amor de Dios.
