







<u>Sacrament of Baptism:</u> The parents of the child are responsible for contacting the Parish office.

#### ❖ WHO MAY BE BAPTIZED AT EPIPHANY:

- Catholic living within the Epiphany boundaries, registered or not
- Catholic living outside the Parish boundaries with some connection to Epiphany **AND must obtain** written permission from their parish of residence, as a matter of courtesy among parishes.

#### ❖ FOR SCHOOL-AGE CHILDREN 6 YEARS UP TO 17 YEARS OF AGE

- Please call the parish office at 415-333-7630 and speak with Director of Religious Education or the assistant in regards to enrolling the child into the Religious Education program.

#### ❖ FOR ADULTS 18 YEARS AND UP

- Contact the parish office 415-333-7630, regarding RCIA (the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults).

#### ❖ GODPARENTS:

- The guidelines from the Archdiocese of San Francisco and Code of Canon Law state," to be Godparent, the person must be:
- a.) appointed by the parents or whoever stands in their place,
- b.) at least 16 years of age,
- c.) a practicing Catholic (living in accord with the Catholic Church's Teachings) who has already received the Sacrament of Confirmation. **If married, must have been married in the Catholic Church**.
- d.) One Male and (or) one Female.
- e.) Completion of Sponsor Eligibility Certificate.

#### STEPS IN THE PREPARATION FOR BATISM OF INFANT UP TO 6 YEARS OF AGE:

- Must be completed by the parent of the child to be Baptized.

#### 2. INTERVIEW:

a.) A meeting with **ONLY** the parents of the child with one of the members of the Baptismal Preparation Team. It is usually about 30-45 minutes. Please contact the Parish office at 415-333-7630 to schedule the interview.

#### 3. BAPTISMAL PREPARATION CLASS: (Please do not bring children)

- PARENTS ARE NOT TO COME TO THE CLASS IF THEY HAVE NOT HAD AN INTERVIEW.
- English: Held once a month on Monday at 6 pm (call Parish to see scheduled days).
  - o Classes to be held in the Parish Office Conference room
- Spanish: held every Third Sunday of each month from 9:30am-11:00am
  - Classes are held in O'Keefe Hall (North East Corner of Amazon Avenue & Naples Street)

#### 4. Baptismal Ceremony:

- English: every Saturday at 11:15am.
- **Spanish:** every 4th Sunday of the month at 2:30pm.

#### 5. Scheduling:

o Please indicate the desired date of Baptism on the Baptism Application. It is recommended that you call the parish office to make sure the date will be available pending other events (Private Masses, First Communions, Confirmations, etc.)

#### 6. Day of Baptism:

- Please arrive 15 minutes early. Baptism will begin promptly at 11:15am/2:30pm. If you arrive too late or do not show up, you may be assessed a rescheduling fee. Please notify the office of any rescheduling at least a week prior.
- Baptism Candles and Stoles (for babies) are provided by the church but are welcome to bring your own.
- Time will be allotted after Baptism for photos, please keep in mind that at times there will be events in the church directly after, we ask you for your patience and courtesy.
- Baptism Certificates will be mailed out the following week after being recorded in the Sacramental Register, please make sure your mailing address is current and correct.

Can. 872 Insofar as possible, a person to be baptized is to be given a sponsor who assists an adult in Christian initiation or together with the parents presents an infant for baptism. A sponsor also helps the baptized person to lead a Christian life in keeping with baptism and to fulfill faithfully the obligations inherent in it.	
Can. 873 There is to be only one male sponsor or one female sponsor or one of each.	
Can. 874 §1. To be permitted to take on the function of sponsor a person must:  1/ be designated by the one to be baptized, by the parents or the person who takes their place, in their absence by the pastor or minister and have the aptitude and intention of fulfilling this function;	
2/ <u>have completed the sixteenth year of age</u> , unless the diocesan bishop has established anoth age, or the pastor or minister has granted an exception for a just cause;	er
3/ be a Catholic who has been confirmed and has already received the most holy sacrament of The Eucharist and who leads a life of faith in keeping with the function to taken on;  [if the sponsor is NOT single, they must have been married in the Catholic Church]	<u>be</u>

§2. A baptized person who belongs to a non-Catholic ecclesial community is not to participate except together with a Catholic sponsor and then only as a witness of the baptism.
