



#### **Immigration Crisis at the** Texas Border



Catholic Charities is responding to the current immigration crisis at the Texas border. As the federal immigration detention and release practices are rapidly shifting and great public attention has been focused on the needs of families. Catholic Charities of the Rio Grande Valley's Humanitarian Respite Center has been inundated with families to welcome, donations to process and volunteers to manage. The Humanitarian Respite Center was opened several years ago by Catholic Charities of the Rio Grande Valley to help families who have recently been released from the detention centers get a hot shower, warm meal, clothing and necessities before continuing their journey across the US to be reunited with their children and families; however, with only a staff of 4 they are overwhelmed as an average of 250 individuals per day walk through their door seeking help.



#### St. Thomas More Catholic Church New Hymnals are coming soon!

St. Thomas More has been using Gather 3<sup>rd</sup> Edition Hymnals since 2008, after the new translation of the Roman Missal was published. While we use many of the songs and hymns from Gather, we have supplemented our musical choices with selections from another Hymnal, Spirit and Song, which has a more contemporary set of songs. This, of course, leads to our use of Worship Aids in many of our services.

We are now going to implement the hardcover Spirit and Song Hymnal in the pews. This will NOT replace Gather, it will be an additional resource for the congregation. We hope the addition of this hymnal will help support better participation in the music of St. Thomas More! Featured in this new Hymnal is one of our familiar Mass parts, Mass of Renewal by Curtis Stephan, as well as many familiar songs.






