






Offertory Gifts Sign Up Book

Members of the St. Thomas More St. Vincent de Paul Society (SVdP) wish to thank all our parishioners for their continued generous financial support. During the SVdP 3rd

quarter (Apr, May, Jun 2018), Vincentians made 82 home visits, helping 168 people! \$48,970 was spent keeping people in their homes or in some form of shelter. \$3,885 was paid to keep electricity on to help keep people stay cool this hot summer! An additional \$6,206 was paid on everything from food, HEB cards for gas, bus passes, car repairs, and other utilities. We continue to support the Vincentian Family Center (VFC) food pantry with \$1000/qrt. This helps feed more than 100 families/week. The families that we visit ask that we thank you for your generous contributions during their time of need.

If you don't recall your User ID/Password, please use the Alternate Login option to access your application. If you have never submitted an EIM application (online or paper copy), use the above link to create your EIM account and complete the application.

An EIM Workshop is required in addition to the EIM application for background check and must be attended every 3 years to remain in EIM compliance. If you are a victim of sexual abuse and have concerns regarding your attendance at a workshop, please contact Emily Hurlimann at (512) 949-2447 to discuss an alternative workshop arrangement.

HOW TO REPORT AN INCIDENT OF CONCERN

The Diocese of Austin is committed to preventing harm from happening to any of our children or vulnerable adults. If you are aware of sexual or physical abuse and/or neglect of a child or vulnerable adult, state law requires you to report that information to local law enforcement or the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services at (800) 252-5400 or www.dfps.state.tx.us. Additionally, if the suspected abuse is by clergy or an employee or volunteer of any diocesan parish, school or agency, a Notice of Concern should be submitted to the diocesan Ethics and Integrity in Ministry Office at (512) 949-2400. The Notice of Concern can be found at www.austindiocese.org (click on REPORT ABUSE OR A NOTICE OF CONCERN). Reports may be made anonymously.


