The Franciscan Sisters of Little Falls, Minnesota, have been engaged in mission activities outside the United States since 1962, when a group of sisters began a mission in Peru. In the ensuing years, sisters went on to serve in other Latin American countries: Bolivia, Venezuela, Guatemala, Columbia, Nicaragua, Ecuador, and Mexico. In Africa, Franciscan Sisters served in Kenya, Tanzania, Cameroon, and Zanzibar as well as shorter service in other countries.

Presently, Franciscan Sisters minister in two locations in Mexico and nurture a relationship with Franciscan Associates in Nicaragua.

As our Parish collaborates with the Missionary Cooperation Plan of the Diocese of Austin, from the Franciscan Sisters of Little Falls, Minnesota, Sister Mary and Sister Ange will speak at the Masses on August 25th and 26th, 2018. 





If you don't recall your User ID/Password, please use the Alternate Login option to access your application. If you have never submitted an EIM application (online or paper copy), use the above link to create your EIM account and complete the application.

An EIM Workshop is required in addition to the EIM application for background check and must be attended every 3 years to remain in EIM compliance.

If you are a victim of sexual abuse and have concerns regarding your attendance at a workshop, please contact Emily Hurlimann at (512) 949-2447 to discuss an alternative workshop arrangement.

REPORTING AN INCIDENT OF CONCERN

The Diocese of Austin is committed to preventing harm from happening to any of our children or vulnerable adults. If you are aware of sexual or physical abuse and/or neglect of a child or vulnerable adult, state law requires you to report that information to local law enforcement or the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services at (800) 252-5400 or www.dfps.state.tx.us. Additionally, if the suspected abuse is by clergy or an employee or volunteer of any diocesan parish, school or agency, a Notice of Concern should be submitted to the diocesan Ethics and Integrity in Ministry Office at (512) 949-2400. The Notice of Concern can be found at www.austindiocese.org (click on REPORT ABUSE OR A NOTICE OF CONCERN). Reports may be made anonymously.
