#### ADOPT-A-STUDENT

The new school year isn't far away. It's time again for our annual Adopt-A-Student project sponsored by Father Hohman Council 5253 of the Knights of Columbus. This benefits families served by the St. Francis Center in McArthur, the county seat of Vinton County. Vinton County is Ohio's smallest county in terms of population and the most impoverished. Many families there cannot afford basic necessities, let alone school supplies.

With your donations, the Knights help fulfill their needs by distributing kits containing basic school supplies. Each kit has a pencil box, five No. 2 pencils, three ballpoint pens, a pair of blunt or pointed scissors, a box of 24-count crayons, a large eraser or three pencil-top erasers, and one large or three small glue sticks.

Also needed are packs of notebook filler paper or loose leaf paper. Teachers can use extra supplies of facial tissues, hand sanitizer, and anti-bacterial wipes. Large sizes in particular are welcome.

Back-to-school sales of these items are beginning at major retail stores and office supply stores, enabling people to increase their generosity by buying more of the above items at lower prices. Watch for sales on these items and **bring them to Mass on the weekends of July 21-22 and July 28-30.** 

These items will be assembled on Monday, July 30. Help will be needed to pack them at 6:30 p.m. in the PAC room. The Knights will take them to McArthur the following day.

Monetary donations also will be gratefully accepted. This will enable us to purchase additional items, which will be needed as the school year continues. Last year, you, the St. Pius parishioners, donated 336 complete kits, plus many extra items and \$2,036 in cash. Donations have grown each year, and we thank you!

Site coordinator, Ashley Riegel, of the St. Francis Center is most grateful for the help she receives each year from this drive. She said that St. Pius X Church has been the main supplier of these items for the students served by the center for many years, and that everything sent from St. Pius X was used during the school year at some point. The center assists people of all faiths, and most of the students receiving the donated items are non-Catholic.



#### **Saint Oliver Plunkett** (*November 1, 1629-July 1, 1681*)

Saint Oliver Plunkett's Story: The name of today's saint is especially familiar to the Irish and the English - and with good reason. The English martyred Oliver Plunkett for defending the faith in his native Ireland during a period of severe persecution.

Born in County Meath in 1629, Oliver studied for the priesthood in Rome and was ordained there in 1654. After some years of teaching and service to the poor of Rome, he was appointed Archbishop of Armagh in Ireland. Four years later, in 1673, a new wave of anti-Catholic persecution began, forcing Archbishop Plunkett to do his pastoral work in secrecy and disguise and to live in hiding. Meanwhile, many of his priests were sent into exile, schools were closed, Church services had to be held in secret, and convents and seminaries were suppressed. As archbishop, Plunkett was viewed as ultimately responsible for any rebellion or political activity among his parishioners.

Archbishop Plunkett was arrested and imprisoned in Dublin Castle in 1679, but his trial was moved to London. After deliberating for 15 minutes, a jury found him guilty of fomenting revolt. He was hanged, drawn, and quartered in July 1681.

Pope Paul VI canonized Oliver Plunkett in 1975.

Stories like that of Oliver Plunkett seem to fit history. "Things like that don't happen today" is often our thought. But they do. False accusations, prejudice, anti-Catholic sentiments, racism, sexism, etc. are still an active reality in our day. Maybe a prayer to Saint Oliver for peace and justice may be appropriate.


