The pulpit talks Father Dave and John Beyer had given the weekend of July 27-28 informed our parishioners of the update for the Capital Campaign for Phase I & II. The recap of all that we have accomplished thus far with Hohman Hall for Youth Ministry and the Latchkey program, the storage in the basement of Hohman Hall saving over \$7,000 each year, the nine meeting rooms in the Msgr. David R. Funk Parish Family Center, the commercial kitchen, the full basement under the kitchen to be used for storage, and the spacious Hall that is currently being rented for events (wedding receptions, graduation parties, anniversary parties, baby showers and the list continues on) providing a new income stream for the Parish, and all the Parish activities in the new facility: shrimp/fish fries, pancake breakfasts, pasta dinners, Christmas parties and all the meetings held on Campus for all the ministries here at St. Pius X Parish and School.

The following we can anticipate with the Narthex (vestibule, rear of church) expansion: Adoration Chapel, doubling the size of the open area to visit with friends, renovated Quietening Room, new Choir Room, new Bride's Room, new bathrooms, a kitchenette and much larger resource racks and Lending Library. Please take the time to respond to the mailing we sent to all registered families inviting everyone to attend a reception in mid-September to learn more about Phase II and become informed. We have invested additional funds during the build to prevent many issues we currently had or would have in the very near future including a fire hydrant on Campus, all new utility lines for water, electric and gas, storm water tie in to French Run Creek for the entire Campus, AV system for the Hall, and many others so that things are being done RIGHT the first time and being prudent with all funds during this build. Father Dave also canceled the Business Office Expansion so that we are trying to be very prudent with our funds and our needs.

SAINT OF THE DAY FOR AUGUST 17

Saint Joan of the Cross (June 18, 1666- August 17, 1736)

Saint Joan of the Cross' Story:

An encounter with a shabby old woman many dismissed as insane prompted Saint Joan to dedicate her life to the poor. For Joan, who had a reputation as a businesswoman intent on monetary success, this was a significant conversion.

Born in 1666 in Anjou, France, Joan worked in the family business—a small shop near a religious shrine—from an early age. After her parents' death she took over the shop. She quickly became known for her greediness and insensitivity to the beggars who often came seeking help.

That was until she was touched by the strange woman who claimed she was on intimate terms with the deity. Joan, who had always been devout, even scrupulous, became a new person. She began caring for needy children. Then the poor, elderly, and sick came to her. Over time, she closed the family business so she could devote herself fully to good works and penance.

She went on to found what came to be known as the Congregation of Saint Anne of Providence. It was then she took the religious name of Joan of the Cross. By the time of her death in 1736 she had founded 12 religious houses, hospices, and schools. Pope John Paul II canonized her in 1982.

The downtown areas of most major cities hold a population of "street people." Well-dressed folks usually avoid making eye contact, probably for fear of being asked for a handout. That was Joan's attitude until the day one of them touched her heart. Most people thought the old woman was crazy, but she put Joan on the road to sainthood. Who knows what the next beggar we meet might do for us?
