PASTOR’S PLATFORM

Make Prayer an Essential Part of this Lent

Wednesday, March 5, 2025, Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of Lenten season. Keep in mind that this season is a time for deepening our relationship with the Lord. The three pillars of Lent – prayer, fasting and almsgiving – serve as guideposts on this 40-day journey. Prayer, in particular, holds a special place in this season of repentance and renewal. Reflections to help guide you in your pursuit of meaningful prayer this Lenten season, some booklets were distributed for this purpose.

Prayer is our communication with the triune God – the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. It is a two-way relationship of both listening and speaking. The Catechism of the Catholic Church says, “This mystery [of faith], then, requires that the faithful believe in it, that they celebrate it, and that they live from it in a vital and personal relationship with the living and true God. This relationship is prayer” (CCC 2558).

During Lent, we are called to pray as a way to connect with God and reflect on Jesus’ sacrifice. Prayer helps us become attuned to God’s voice, seek forgiveness and grow closer to Him. It’s a time for self-reflection and renewal, inviting us to align our lives with God’s will. Through prayer, we find comfort, hope and strength in knowing that God is with us during our journey through Lent and beyond.

Many saints have offered their personal reflections on what prayer is and how it unites us to God: “Prayer is a surge of the heart, it is a simple look turned toward heaven, it is a cry of recognition and of love, embracing both trial and joy.” – St. Therese of Lisieux. “Prayer is the raising of one’s mind and heart to God or the requesting of good things from God.” – St. John of Damascus. “Whether we realize it or not, prayer is the encounter of God’s thirst with ours. God thirsts that we may thirst for Him.” – St. Augustine.

Prayer is an essential component of growth in our relationship with the living God. If we have not already been incorporating prayer into our daily lives, Lent is an excellent time to start. We begin by reconciling ourselves to God.

“This season of lent reminds us that God wants us to be reconciled to Him and to one another. For He wants us to shed anger, bitterness and resentments that could decay our souls. If we truly desire God’s love and mercy, we must learn to humble ourselves and seek not only divine forgiveness but to establish life-giving relationships around us.”

Reconciliation comes through the Sacrament of Confession. As we set our relationship right with God, we can simultaneously add a manageable habit of prayer into our daily routine. Pray daily a decade of the Holy Rosary, examine your conscience daily, read and reflect on the daily Mass readings and spend five minutes in silence every day, asking the Lord to speak to us.

For those who have already developed a consistent habit in their daily lives in prayer, try adding something of greater intensity for the season of Lent such as attending daily Mass, praying a whole Rosary or chaplet every day or spending an extended period of time in silent contemplation in Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament.
