**The New Stations of the Cross**

When I came to St. Pius X Parish, it was my commitment to guide the parishioners of this parish to focus on Christ in the blessed sacrament of the Holy Eucharist and to promote reverence and adoration of the Holy Eucharist. And another thing is to make the worship space as beautiful as we can and with as few distractions as possible while having key holy images that can help us reflect and meditate on the mystery of our salvation, the Stations of the Cross took the first place. So, we looked at different options and fortunately one of our parishioners is a sculptor and member of the Knights. We looked at the designs and the costs. Mike Vail patiently and diligently shaped and designed the Stations of the Cross with his skills to their current appearance.

After this beautiful work was done and ready for installation, Mike handed the stations to me as well as Mike and Mary Vail's family donation to St. Pius X Parish, the parish they love and are committed to. I would like to extend my heartfelt gratitude and that of the whole parish towards the Vail Family for their generosity and commitment to their faith and our beloved parish community. Other works to complete the job to its current state was from the saving from the Capital Campaign and some from the Lenten soups of the year 2024 and Swisher Family contribution. Our appreciation to Swisher Family and all you parishioners. In other words, all of us have participated and contributed to this project. Mike Vail and Tom Vollmer did the installation under the guidance and direction of Scott Marsh – St. Pius X Director of Facilities. And Waibel Electric did the wiring and lighting system.

The Stations of the Cross are highly significant as a devotional practice that allows believers to meditate on and deeply contemplate the suffering and death of Jesus Christ during His final hours, essentially "walking with Him" through His journey to Calvary by reflecting on key moments depicted in 14 stations, providing a powerful opportunity for prayer and personal connection to Christ's sacrifice for humanity; this practice is particularly important during Lent, especially on Good Friday, when the events of the Passion are commemorated.

Let us continue praying the Stations, as we meditate on each station, may we deepen our faith, strengthen our commitment to discipleship, and embrace the transformative power of Christ's Passion in our lives.
