


Welcome to ST. PIUS X CATHOLIC CHURCH

PASTOR'S PLATFORM

Catholic Education is Important for Your Children and Sunday Obligation

Greetings and best regards. I take this opportunity to thank those who have entrusted their children to us at St. Pius X School. A Catholic presence in one's life establishes a strong foundation for learning, and it promotes cognitive, social, emotional, and spiritual development of all children. At St. Pius X Catholic School, we provide a learning environment for the children to become closer to their faith and to God. We are humbled by God's grace to care for these children you have entrusted to us. Catholic education as a whole aims at instilling a strong moral foundation and develop well-rounded individuals who are equipped to contribute positively to society. It emphasizes faith formation, civic engagement, and service to others, encouraging students to become ethical and compassionate citizens. At St. Pius X School, we equip our students with the courage to help those in need. We instill in them values to understand right from wrong and work to create engaged citizens who respect the rights and feelings of others.

We do teach Christ's core values to these children: love, generosity, responsibility, self-discipline, and more. We teach them how to be responsible, good people who care for their community and try to emulate Christ in addition to science and literature. Also we provide them with the invaluable opportunity to expand their knowledge, explore their passions, create community, strengthen their sense of self and come to know God all in one place.

The purpose of life is to have life and have it more abundantly. For this reason, we constantly help them to love God with all their heart, mind and soul and to love their neighbor as themselves. Through services, our students learn empathy, kindness, respect for others and oneself, the ability to distinguish right from wrong, and how to practice values that help them lead good lives and become a positive force in the world. Students are guided to accept responsibility for their actions, to respect others and to make good decisions in the context of their faith experience. The goal is to help children mature into Christ-like people. One of the main activities is weekday school Mass once a week on Tuesdays which doesn't substitute the Sunday obligation.

I take this chance to request and encourage parents and guardians to continue this process in the homes. Take it upon yourselves, the responsibility of taking the children to Sunday Mass, Holy Days of Obligation and other sacraments. In Catholicism, the Sunday obligation mandates that faithful Catholics attend Mass on Sundays and certain other Holy Days of Obligation. This obligation also includes refraining from engaging in work or activities that hinder worship, joy, works of mercy, and appropriate relaxation these days. While generally understood as attending Mass, it also encompasses resting and abstaining from activities that impede the proper observance of the day.

The Code of Canon Law states that faithful Catholics are obliged to participate in the Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation, unless a legitimate reason prevents them. The Sunday obligation also includes resting from activities that hinder worship, such as some kinds of work that would impede the proper observance of the day. Attending Mass on Sundays is a central part of fulfilling this obligation, as it's a day of communal worship and receiving the Eucharist. Besides Sundays, certain other Holy Days of Obligation, such as Christmas and other feasts, also require Mass attendance. There are legitimate reasons that may excuse a Catholic from the obligation to attend Mass, such as illness, care for a family member, or other serious circumstances. But intentionally missing Mass without a legitimate reason is considered a mortal sin. The Church's reasoning for the Sunday obligation includes the moral law to worship God, the significance of the Mass as a way to worship, and the early Christians' practice of gathering on the first day of the week for the Eucharist.



Job Description: A childhood development associate (CDA) working to create a successful learning environment for children 3 to 5 years old.

Responsibilities:

- Supervision of a group of children in a school setting.
- Establish and maintain a safe and healthy environment following all State Licensing, Ohio Department of Children and Youth, and Diocese of Columbus requirements.
- Establish and maintain positive and productive relationships with children and families.
- Incorporate Heggerty and PreK On My Way curriculums and Ohio Early Learning and Development Standards into their curriculum and assessment.
- Observe and evaluate each child’s progress throughout the year and provide information about each child to parents during conferences twice a year (Oct/Jan).
- Maintain a clean and clutter free classroom and center environment.
- Attend and participate in staff meetings and in-service training.
- Demonstrate a high level of professional and ethical behavior that includes appropriate interactions with students, parents, and other staff.
- All other duties as necessary for creating a successful preschool program: reports to Preschool Co-Directors.

- Certified or willing to be certified in CPR, First Aid, Communicable Disease and Child Abuse (training can be provided after hiring).
