PASTOR'S PLATFORM

A Corpus Christi Eucharistic Procession on Sunday, June 22, 2025

On this Solemnity of The Body and Blood of Christ: *Corpus Christi* the procession will be held at St. Pius X Parish after 10:00 a.m. Mass. It is a “public witness of faith and worship of the Most Blessed Sacrament” (Holy Communion and Worship of the Eucharist Outside Mass [HCWEOM], 101). This is founded upon the Church’s belief that Jesus becomes substantially present (i.e., real) to us in the Eucharist at Mass. The *Corpus Christi* procession is one of the ways in which we express our devotion to Christ (Eucharistic adoration, Forty Hours devotions, and visits to the Blessed Sacrament are some of the Church’s other forms of devotion).

This Eucharistic Procession will be celebrated annually on the Solemnity of Corpus Christi at St. Pius X Church. It will involve carrying the Blessed Sacrament in a monstrance through the campus and neighborhood which will be accompanied by prayers, hymns, and flowers. This is a way, for us, to publicly proclaim our belief in Christ’s presence and to invite others to worship and adore him. It is a public profession of Faith, a Eucharistic Adoration and a pilgrimage to Heaven.

It will begin after Mass, at which the host for the procession is consecrated, placed in a monstrance. The Blessed Sacrament is then carried out of the church and through the campus and the neighborhood, accompanied by the parishioners.

This procession has a special importance and meaning for our pastoral life in this parish and our neighbors. When the Eucharist is carried around in a solemn procession with singing, we give public witness of faith and devotion toward the sacrament (HCWEOM, 101, 102).

Pope Saint John Paul II says, “The devout participation of the faithful in the Eucharistic procession on the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ is a grace from the Lord which yearly brings joy to those who take part in it” (*Ecclesia de Eucharistia*, 10). He continues: “In the humble signs of bread and wine, changed into the body and blood, Christ walks beside us as our strength and our food for the journey, and he enables us to become, for everyone, witnesses of hope” (62).




