## PASTOR'S PLATFORM

### Spiritual significance and symbolism of the Immaculate Heart of Mary

The Immaculate Heart of Mary is a Catholic devotion that symbolizes the Virgin Mary's love, purity, and compassion, and her role in salvation history. It represents her interior life, including her joys and sorrows, and her virtues. The Immaculate Heart of Mary also symbolizes her virginal love for God, her maternal love for Jesus, and her love for all people.

The Immaculate Heart of Mary represents Mary's faithfulness to God, despite experiencing both joys and sorrows. The Immaculate Heart of Mary shows how Mary conformed to Christ in the Holy Spirit, and how she is a model disciple. The Immaculate Heart of Mary shows how Mary was filled with the Holy Spirit, and how she is a Temple of God. The Immaculate Heart of Mary symbolizes Mary's grief for the sins of mankind. The Immaculate Heart of Mary is often depicted with seven swords or wounds piercing her heart, representing: mental suffering/anguish/grief/sorrow of Mary. Roses, usually red or white, are also often wrapped around the heart.

Pope Pius XII instituted the feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary in 1944, after the apparitions of Our Lady of Fatima. The feast is celebrated on Saturday following the feast of the Sacred Heart, celebrated June 28, 2025, this year. Whether you are a devoted Catholic or an individual on a quest to explore faith, comprehending the symbolism of this sacred Catholic icon can enrich your spiritual journey. Additionally, the Immaculate Heart's enduring appeal lies in its ability to convey profound love, which resonates with those who appreciate the power of faith-inspired gifts.

The Immaculate Heart of Mary essentially, represents both the spiritual and physical heart of Mary, the Mother of Jesus, symbolizing her pure, boundless love for all humanity and her grief for the sins of mankind. The feast of the Immaculate Heart, traditionally observed the day after the Sacred Heart of Jesus feast, serves as a further tribute to this emblem of unwavering love and compassion. Frequently depicted as a heart adorned with roses, pierced by a sword, or adorned with flames, the Immaculate Heart of Mary image portrays Mary's fervent love for God and mankind.


