PASTOR'S PLATFORM

WE ARE INVITED TO BE VIGILANT AND ATTENTIVE TO ACTION

Imagine an important person calling you to ask for a favor. Most likely you would drop all you were doing and respond immediately. But, sadly, when the King of the Universe attempts to speak to us and inspire us to some mission, we can be too distracted to even listen, let alone respond with immediacy and zeal. If, however, a person is continually attentive to the voice of God and responds to His interior promptings as soon as they are received, then Jesus says that this person is truly blessed and that He will "have the servants recline at table and proceed to wait on them." In other words, the result of being vigilant in our attentiveness to the inspirations of God is that God Himself will reward us with His service. He will invite us to the table of spiritual rest, peace, joy, and fulfillment. He will serve us His mercy, which will be more than we could ever imagine.

So, my dear brothers and sisters; Vigilance, hard work, determination, attentiveness, fidelity – are the qualities that Jesus is speaking about. To "gird your loins" means that you are immediately prepared for some challenging tasks. You are ready for the hard work ahead and are committed to it. To "light your lamps" implies that you are not in the dark but that your mind is enlightened in such a way that you are able to see that which is the will of God.

As we go through life, it is easy to become complacent in the things of faith. It is easy to become lazy, disinterested, distracted, and unfocused. This parable goes on to speak of a thief who tries to break into a house in the middle of the night. This is Jesus' way of saying that the evil one, with his lies and attacks, is constant, vicious, forceful, and unpredictable. For that reason, we must never grow tired of being vigilant in the spiritual life and must always be attentive to the light of God's voice.

Are we attentive to the mission of Christ on a daily basis? This is an essential question to answer honestly. Most people will find that they become distracted from the mission God has given to them. We experience countless things every day that compete for our attention. Many of those competing voices might not appear to be sinful. A certain hobby becomes the dominant focus of your free time. Responsibilities at work have spilled over into your family time. Painful or even enjoyable experience has had your full attention for some time. Though it is obvious that sinful distractions in life are evil, it might not always be as obvious that there are many other neutral distractions that are a real problem. The problems they can produce are a lack of attentiveness to the will of God and a lack of readiness to engage the will of God the moment He calls.

Let us always be attentive to God's voice as He speaks. Together we reflect upon how aware we are of His constant presence in our life and His ongoing communication. If we can form a habit of always listening, then we will never miss out on the grace-filled mission given to us by our Lord. Always listen to Him, seek out His still and gentle voice, and be ready to respond to Him every time He calls.



KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS – ADOPT-A-STUDENT

The new school year isn't far away and, once again, the Knights of Columbus Father Hohman Council 5253 is proud to sponsor its annual **Adopt-A-Student school supply collection** for families served by the St.

Francis Center in McArthur, the county seat of Vinton County. Vinton County is Ohio's smallest county in terms of population and one of the most impoverished. Many families there cannot afford basic necessities, let alone school supplies.

With your donation, the Knights help fulfill their needs by distributing kits containing basic school supplies. Each kit has a pencil box, five No. 2 pencils, three ballpoint pens, a pair of blunt or pointed scissors, a box of 24-count crayons, a large eraser or three pencil-top erasers, and one large or three small glue sticks.

Also needed are packs of notebook filler paper or loose leaf paper. Teachers can use extra supplies of facial tissues, hand sanitizer, and antibacterial wipes. Large sizes in particular are welcome.

Back-to-school sales of these items are beginning at major retail stores and office supply stores, enabling people to increase their generosity by buying more of the above items at lower prices. Watch for sales on these items and please bring them to Mass on the weekend of August 9-10. Please place all items in the donation bins located at the side entrance of the church or bring them to the table set up in the Narthex before or after Mass. Any monetary donations can be placed in the collection basket or brought to the table set up in the Narthex before or after Mass.

These items will be assembled Thursday, August 14th at 7:00 p.m. Help will be needed to pack the items. The Knights will take them to McArthur the following day.

Monetary donations also will be gratefully accepted. This will enable us to purchase additional items, which will be needed as the school year continues.

Last year, we delivered 330 completed school kits, over \$500.00 in monetary donations, and numerous additional supplies. Please consider donating to help those less fortunate.


