



**THE REAL PRESENCE OF JESUS IN THE EUCHARIST**

My dearly beloved in Christ. Perhaps every one of us Catholics has heard of the word, “transubstantiation.” St. Thomas Aquinas gave us this verbiage to explain the miracle taking place at Mass. Before I describe that miracle, I want to be very clear, the Eucharist is not a symbol that represents Jesus, The Eucharist is Emmanuel! God with us! The Eucharist is Jesus! The very same Jesus that was born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontus Pilate, was crucified, and rose from Dead, is truly, really, and substantially present in the Holy Eucharist, but hidden under the forms of bread and wine. This has been the belief of the Church since the time of The Apostles. Transubstantiation describes how this happens.

At Mass, Jesus, the High Priest of the New and Eternal covenant, by His divine power, works through His ministerial priests to bring about a miraculous change. At Jesus’ words during consecration, and by the power of the Holy Spirit, the underlying reality of the bread and wine are completely changed into the Lord’s body, blood, soul, and divinity! The appearance of bread and wine remain after consecration, but the underlying reality of the bread and wine, becomes Jesus present, whole and entire, in all His Divinity and humanity.

Recall Jesus’ words at The Last Supper, “THIS IS MY BODY.” The Lord did not say that this is like my body, or that this represents my body. Instead, He said, “THIS IS MY BODY. THIS IS MY BLOOD.” Exactly one year before The Last Supper, Jesus made it clear to his followers that He would give His very self in the Eucharist. Our Lord said, “I AM THE LIVING BREAD THAT HAS COME DOWN FROM HEAVEN, WHOEVER EATS THIS BREAD WILL LIVE FOREVER, AND THE BREAD THAT I WILL GIVE IS MY FLESH FOR THE LIFE OF THE WORLD.” (John 6:51)

His followers, some of whom left their homes and families to be His disciples, were shocked at His words, and asked one another, “How can this man give us his flesh to eat?” “Jesus knew that they understood Him literally. Jesus did not retract what he said or explain it away as a metaphor or a quaint hyperbole, but insisted, “TRULY, TRULY I SAY TO YOU, UNLESS YOU EAT THE FLESH OF THE SON OF MAN AND DRINK HIS BLOOD, YOU HAVE NO LIFE WITHIN YOU.” What many of Jesus followers failed to understand was that He was referring to consuming His risen body and blood. His glorified body after the resurrection was unlimited by time and space. His risen body could appear and disappear; it could pass through walls. His listeners did not understand this, nor did they comprehend that God incarnate was speaking to them.

Many of His followers sadly ceased to be His disciples. When Jesus witnessed the crowds leaving in great numbers, He did not retract, but emboldened His teaching by declaring, “MY FLESH IS REAL FOOD AND MY BLOOD, IS REAL DRINK.” Then He intensified His words further by saying, “... WHOEVER EATS MY FLESH AND DRINKS MY BLOOD REMAINS IN ME AND I IN HIM.” After Jesus reiterated His teaching on the Real Presence four times, and huge numbers of His followers departed, Jesus turned to his twelve closest disciples and asked if they would abandon Him also. The twelve had a choice whether to believe Jesus or not.

Peter and the disciples did not fully understand the meaning of the Real Presence, but knew that Jesus is the Son of God, and that He had the power to do anything He wills. Because of that, He is worthy of total trust. Friends, the little white host is Jesus! The tiny white circle known as the Eucharist is Jesus! The Lord is present, body, blood, soul, and divinity, under the appearance of bread and wine. That is why at Mass our entire congregation kneels during the consecration, that is why we genuflect before the tabernacle, that is why we should never receive holy communion with serious sin on our souls, and that is why we must never leave mass early except for a serious reason. Because the Eucharist is Jesus, and not a symbol, we are called to spend personal time in prayer with Him, in our church, in adoration.

I am happy to announce that our goal of St. Pius X Parish is to always (24 hours a day seven days a week) have at least one person praying before the Lord, truly present in the Blessed Sacrament. Everyone is invited to help this parish reach this monumental goal on “Invitation Sunday” that will take place October 25 & 26. May God be glorified! May His people be sanctified! Mother Mary, pray for us! Blessed Carlo Acutis, pray for us!





**Saturday, Feb 28th:** Today you depart on your overnight flight to Rome.

**Sunday, Mar 1 - ROME - ASSISI**  
Upon arrival, the tour escort, who will be with you throughout the tour, will meet you and escort you to your deluxe chartered coach. The group will then be taken to Assisi and upon arrival we will visit Santa Maria degli Angeli for a visit and Mass. Check into your hotel for a brief rest period. After we will be transported by smaller vans to visit San Damiano. San Damiano is a church with a monastery near Assisi, Italy. Built in the 12th century, it was the first monastery of the Order of Saint Clare, where Saint Clare built her community. You will after be transported back to the center of Assisi where you will have the rest of the day to explore. We will meet this evening for a group dinner. (B,D)

**Tuesday, Mar 3 - ASSISI-ROME**  
After Breakfast we will depart for Rome via Orvieto. We will visit the Basilica and have free time for an early lunch. After lunch we will continue on to Rome. We will then visit 2 of the 4 major basilicas in the historical city. We will begin with St. Mary Major where Mary is said to have appeared in 352 to Pope Liberius and to a wealthy man named John Patricius. For this reason it is also known as Our Lady of the Snows. After Mass (St. John Lateran or Mary Major) we will check into the Michelangelo Hotel which is a 5-minute walk to the Vatican. They are named after the deacon St. Callixtus who, at the beginning of the 3rd century AD, was assigned by Pope Zephyrinus to the administration of the cemetery. You will have a visit of the catacombs and Mass will be celebrated here. We will enjoy an included lunch before heading back to Rome's Historical Center. The rest of the day is at your leisure. Your farewell dinner will be in a local restaurant. (B,L,D)
