

**PASTOR PLATFORM**

**MEANING AND PRACTICE OF MASS INTENTIONS**

The most important event in human history happens every single day, in our Catholic churches and/or chapels, often on a modest altar dressed in white. The pinnacle of this event comes in the form of bread and wine. This event bends time and space and unites us to God himself. This magnificent, mysterious, and awe-inspiring event is the Catholic Mass.

Our Catholic Mass is the highest form of worship. Members of the Body of Christ come together and enter the celebration of Christ's Passion in which He becomes fully present in the Eucharist. The Eucharist has the appearance of bread and wine but becomes the "Body and Blood of Jesus Christ through the power of the Holy Spirit and the instrumentality of the priest" in the Mass.

This celebration is not merely a reenactment, but the same, real sacrifice taking place. The Catechism of the Catholic Church states:

*"The victim is one and the same: the same now offered through the ministry of priests, who then offered himself on the cross; only the manner of offering is different." "In this divine sacrifice which is celebrated in the Mass, the same Christ who offered himself once in a bloody manner on the altar of the cross is contained and is offered in an unbloody manner" (CCC 1367).*

The Catholic Mass comprises two main parts: the Liturgy of the Word and the Liturgy of the Eucharist. The Liturgy of the Word consists of readings from Scripture. On Sunday there is often one reading from the Old Testament, one reading from the New Testament, and the proclamation of the Gospel. Through the Scriptures in the Liturgy of the Word "God speaks to us, leading us along the path to salvation."

The Liturgy of the Eucharist is a prayer of thanksgiving. It is the pinnacle of the Mass, the time when Jesus becomes fully present to us. The priest, acting in the person of Christ, offers the bread and wine on the altar and joins them to Christ's perfect sacrifice.

Mass Intention is whenever a priest celebrates Mass, he has at least two specific intentions. The first intention is to celebrate the Mass according to the rubrics the Church provided for how to say the Mass. The second is to apply the grace of that Mass toward a specific need or intention.

Catholic Mass is the most powerful form of prayer, it is a common practice to have it offered for a specific intention. Having a Mass said for someone is a powerful way to intercede or pray for them on their behalf. This is commonly referred to as a Mass intention or Mass request which is indicated in the parish bulletin clearly stipulating the intention.

An individual may ask a priest to offer a Mass for several reasons: for example, in thanksgiving, for the intentions of another person (such as on a birthday, on a wedding anniversary, during a time of illness etc., or for the repose of the soul of someone who has died). So, it is a specific offering of a Mass in honor of or in memory of someone by name at a specific Mass time on a specific date. Traditionally, it is offered as a gift to someone who is grieving a recent loss or celebrating a milestone.

When the main celebrant uncovers the paten, we can mentally place all our intentions on the host. The priest says: "Pray, brethren, that my sacrifice and yours may be acceptable to God, the almighty Father." The phrase "and yours" refers to our personal sacrifices and intentions that we unite with the one sacrifice of Christ.

You can have these Mass intentions registered and published at the Church office during office days/hours.
