The school students will be our lectors for the masses for the weekend of January 29th and 30th.

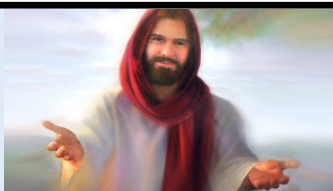
PRAY TO PROTECT HUMAN LIFE: JOIN A NOVENA JANUARY 19-27, 2022!

**Reflection on “Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection
of Unborn Children”**

*In all the dioceses of the United States of America,
January 22 (or January 23, when January 22 falls on a
Sunday) shall be observed as a particular day of prayer
for the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right
to life and of penance for violations to the dignity of the
human person committed through acts of abortion.
The Christian faithful will commit themselves to the ener-
getic promotion of a new culture of life knowing that God
always gives the grace necessary to observe his com-
mandments, and that in every human being, above all in
the least among us, one meets Christ himself.*

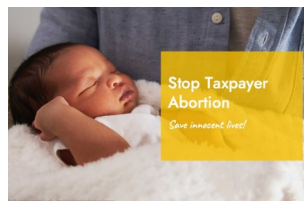

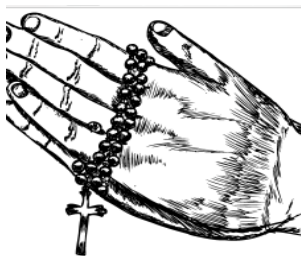
