Religion: We will finish up Chapter 3, Sin in our World, this week. I will send home a study guide on Wednesday. We will have a review game on Thursday and our test will be Friday.

Math: This will be a fun week of learning addition strategies, subtraction concepts, and using variables in expressions. We continue with our addition timed quizzes. We are doing great, but it never hurts to work on flashcards at home.

Reading: This week our first novel comes to a close. Ask your child what very mischievous thing Fudge does in the last chapter. Then something special happens to Peter. It is a great ending to a very humorous book. Our test will be on Thursday. I will send home the vocabulary words on Tuesday for review at home.

Science: We start off this week with review today and our test Tuesday. We will continue to use that knowledge in our next set of lessons, as we continue our study of Botany this week. Our studies lead us to learn about the life cycle of gymnosperms and angiosperms, describing the function and structure of flowers, and seed development in angiosperms.

Social Studies: Students will learn how each region's natural and capital resources shaped the industries that grew there and explain the difference between renewable and nonrenewable resources. Students will identify resources in the Northeast Region and learn about human resources, the people who make products and/or provide services and jobs for others.

Language/Vocabulary: We will begin Unit 3 in our vocabulary workbook and spelling this week. Our vocabulary and spelling tests will be on Friday! We will also finish up our study in mechanics and usage, correcting run-on sentences, and begin personal narrative writing, with a focus on sequencing events in a true story about ourselves.
