Religion: This week we will talk about the season of Advent and its significance in our lives. We have finished up our first unit and will have a final open book test on Tuesday. Each Wednesday we will gather with our floor for an Advent prayer.

Math: With a quick review of addition with larger numbers today, we will then move to addition with three of more addends. Before we break for Christmas, we will have a fact test. After this test we will continue to work on addition, but move down to 4.5 minutes. We will have a few check ins before the test.

Science: Our study of vertebrates is going well. This week we learn to identify characteristics of classes of vertebrates, and describing their life cycles. Next week we will complete our study guide and our test will be next Wednesday, December 13th.

Reading: We are enjoying Dear Mr. Henshaw. Leigh has just found out that his dad, has a girlfriend with a son and he feels betrayed by him. This is the turning point in the book. Leigh starts to make strides in his friendships and with his mom.

Social Studies: Students did a FABULOUS job on their Beautiful Northeast Lesson 1 test on Friday! I am so impressed with their positive attitudes toward learning in social studies and it shows up on their tests!!! Bravo Grade 4!!! We begin lesson 2 this week learning about important resources of the Northeast such as grapes/vineyards, Cranberries/bogs, Vermont maple syrup, and minerals such as granite in New Hampshire quarries and marble in Vermont.

Language: We will study Unit 7 in vocabulary and spelling this week. Both tests will be next week due to the half day on Friday, as we will not meet for ELA + SS class. In addition to vocabulary and spelling, we will continue in ELA chapter 2 and explore nouns ending with y, plural nouns with special plural forms, and common and proper nouns.
