For the required book reading, **HANDWRITE...** *(no typed summaries please)* a **1-2 page** summary that should include 3 paragraphs of the beginning, middle, and end of the story as follows on white lined paper:

- title of the book - (beginning)
- author's name - (beginning)
- description of the setting - (beginning)
- names of the main character/s - (beginning)
- the problem and solution in the story - (middle *may be 2 paragraphs*)
- A book review: Write your *personal opinion* telling why you *liked or did not like* the book and *why you would or would not* recommend reading the book to a friend. - (end)

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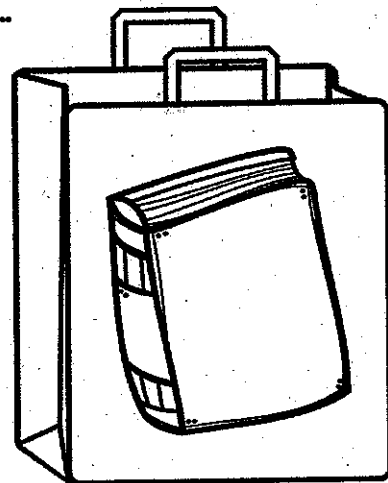

PAPER BAG

BOOK REPORT



Your assignment is to decorate a paper bag related to a fictional book. You will also include illustrations, text and even a few items inside!

FRONT OF BAG: Include the title of the book and an illustration. Also include the author, number of pages, and the number of stars you would give the book if you were a book critic. The maximum number is 5 stars.

RIGHT SIDE: List the main characters and write 1-2 sentences about each. Also, you must describe the setting of the book in 3-4 sentences.

LEFT SIDE: Design a game that is based on the story. It can be a puzzle, word search, word scramble, maze, crossword puzzle or any other fun activity. Make sure that it includes information from the book.

BACK OF BAG: Write a one-paragraph summary that summarizes the plot of the book. Make sure it includes the main conflict and solution in the book.

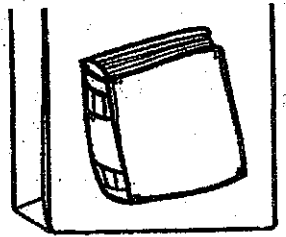
INSIDE THE BAG: Inside the bag you will place 2-3 objects that represent the book. The items must be small enough to fit entirely within the bag. Write a short explanation of how each item pertains to the book and place inside as well.

DON'T FORGET!

Proofread carefully to avoid errors in grammar, spelling and/or punctuation. Your Paper Bag Book Report must be colorful and creatively designed. The bag must be neatly assembled and written portions need to be easy to read!
