Thirty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time
November 10, 2019

FOCUS: The God we worship is the God of the living.

In putting Jesus on the spot, the Sadducees were unexpectedly rewarded with a firm declaration of the truth of the Resurrection. By proclaiming God to be the God of the living, Jesus strengthens the resolve of all who place their trust in him and who hope in a share in the eternal life of God.

LITURGY OF THE WORD: Our first reading from Maccabees recalls the bravery of seven brothers and their mother who preferred death to denying their hope in the God of Israel. Saint Paul reminds the Thessalonians of God's fidelity and encourages them to find hope and strength in the Lord. In the Gospel, the Sadducees attempt to put Jesus on the spot on the topic of resurrection.

REFLECTION: Is death the final chapter of our personal history? Life not only awaits us on the other side of death. But there is new life for us now as we go through the other deaths, more than one or two, we experience in this life. Our God offers us life, not only for the next life, but also now, whenever we are confronted by death in its many guises.

So we ask ourselves:

- How has death already affected our life?
- Who and what have sustained us during the times we have experienced death?

A Minute In the Church (by Gus Lloyd)

Who Can be Saved?

Will heaven be full of only Catholics? Or maybe just Christians? Can anyone else be saved?

First, the Church has always taught that faith in Jesus Christ and in the One who sent Him is necessary for salvation. What about people who have never heard the Gospel? Or those who never understood it? Can they get to heaven? The answer is only God knows.

Here's what the Catechism of the Catholic Church says in paragraph 1260: "Since Christ died for all, and since all men are in fact called to one and the same destiny, which is divine, we must hold that the Holy Spirit offers to all the possibility of being made partakers, in a way known to God, of the Paschal mystery. Every man who is ignorant of the Gospel of Christ and of his Church, but seeks the truth and does the will of God in accordance with his understanding of it, can be saved."

So while the Church is tasked with spreading and teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and salvation through Him, God alone is the judge of souls.
