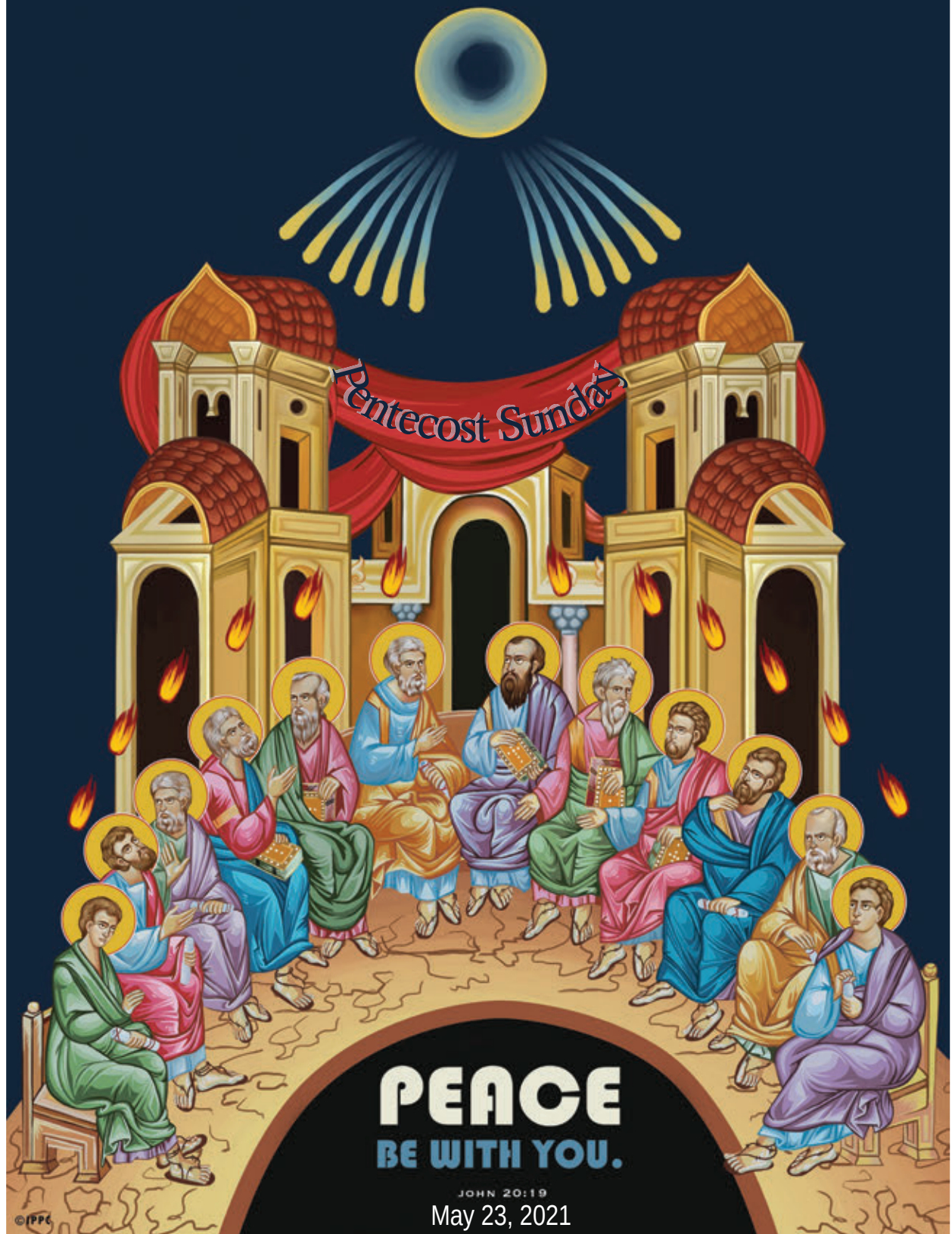

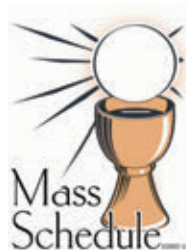

Pentecost Sunday May 23, 2021

FOCUS: The gift of the Holy Spirit empowers Christ's Church to preach the Gospel.

The gift of the Holy Spirit, promised by Jesus at the Last Supper, enables Jesus' disciples to boldly proclaim the Good News, continuing Jesus' mission. As we celebrate Pentecost, we are called to open our hearts to the same Spirit so that we too might do our part in the work of the Kingdom.



LITURGY OF THE WORD: In the first reading, the Holy Spirit descends upon the disciples who were all in one place together. They began proclaiming the Gospel in different languages and all could understand them. Saint Paul encourages the Galatians to live by the Spirit, and lists the fruits of the Spirit that will arise from doing so. Jesus promises his disciples that he and the Father will send the Advocate, who will guide them and glorify Christ.

REFLECTION: Difficult situations like peacemaking, forgiving, working tirelessly for the poor and the work of justice, require what Acts tells us about the Spirit: it is with us like a "strong driving wind," and gifts us with language – just what we Christians need for the long haul in a sometimes-resistant church and world.

So we ask ourselves:

- What difficult challenges am I facing for which I need energy from the Spirit?
- In difficult situations do I call on the Holy Spirit for help?

First Reading ~ Acts of the Apostles**2:1-11**

When the time for Pentecost was fulfilled, they were all in one place together. And suddenly there came from the sky a noise like a strong driving wind, and it filled the entire house in which they were. Then there appeared to them tongues as of fire, which parted and came to rest on each one of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different tongues, as the Spirit enabled them to proclaim.

Now there were devout Jews from every nation under heaven staying in Jerusalem. At this sound, they gathered in a large crowd, but they were confused because each one heard them speaking in his own language. They were astounded, and in amazement they asked, "Are not all these people who are speaking Galileans? Then how does each of us hear them in his native language? We are Parthians, Medes, and Elamites, inhabitants of Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the districts of Libya near Cyrene, as well as travelers from Rome, both Jews and converts to Judaism, Cretans and Arabs, yet we hear them speaking in our own tongues of the mighty acts of God."

Second Reading**Letter of St. Paul to Corinthians****12:3-7, 12-13**

Brothers and sisters: No one can say, "Jesus is Lord," except by the Holy Spirit.

There are different kinds of spiritual gifts but the same Spirit;
there are different forms of service but the same Lord;
there are different workings but the same God who produces all of them in everyone. To each individual the manifestation of the Spirit is given for some benefit.

As a body is one though it has many parts, and all the parts of the body, though many, are one body, so also Christ. For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, slaves or free persons, and we were all given to drink of one Spirit.

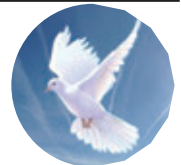

Gifts of the Holy Spirit

At our Baptism, we receive the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit, only to be strengthened when we are Confirmed. The reception of the Sacrament of Confirmation is necessary for the completion of baptismal grace and by receiving this sacrament we are enriched with a special strength of the Holy Spirit. We become true witnesses of Christ, more strictly obliged to spread and defend the faith by word and deed.



- ♦ Wisdom ~ We begin to see God at work in our lives and in the world. We see God as our Father and other people with dignity. We are able to see God in everyone and in everything.
- ♦ Understanding ~ We comprehend how we need to live as a follower of Christ. A person with understanding is not confused by all the conflicting messages in our culture about the right way to live.
- ♦ Counsel (Right Judgment) ~ We now know the difference between right and wrong, and we choose to do what is right. A person with right judgment avoids sin and lives out the values taught by Jesus.
- ♦ Fortitude (Courage) ~ With the gift of fortitude/courage, we overcome our fear and are willing to take risks as a follower of Jesus Christ. A person with courage is willing to stand up for what is right in the sight of God, even if it means accepting rejection, verbal abuse, or even physical harm and death.
- ♦ Knowledge ~ With the gift of knowledge, we understand the meaning of God. The gift of knowledge is more than an accumulation of facts.
- ♦ Piety (Reverence) ~ With the gift of reverence, sometimes called piety, we have a deep sense of respect for God and the church. A person with reverence recognizes our total reliance on God and comes before God with humility, trust, and love.
- ♦ Fear of the Lord (Wonder and Awe) ~ With the gift of fear of the Lord we are aware of the glory and majesty of God. A person with wonder and awe knows that God is the perfection of all we desire: perfect knowledge, perfect goodness, perfect power, and perfect love. Fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom because it puts our mindset in its correct location with respect to God: we are the finite, dependent creatures, and He is the infinite, all-powerful Creator.

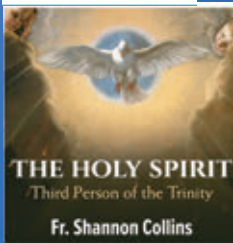
