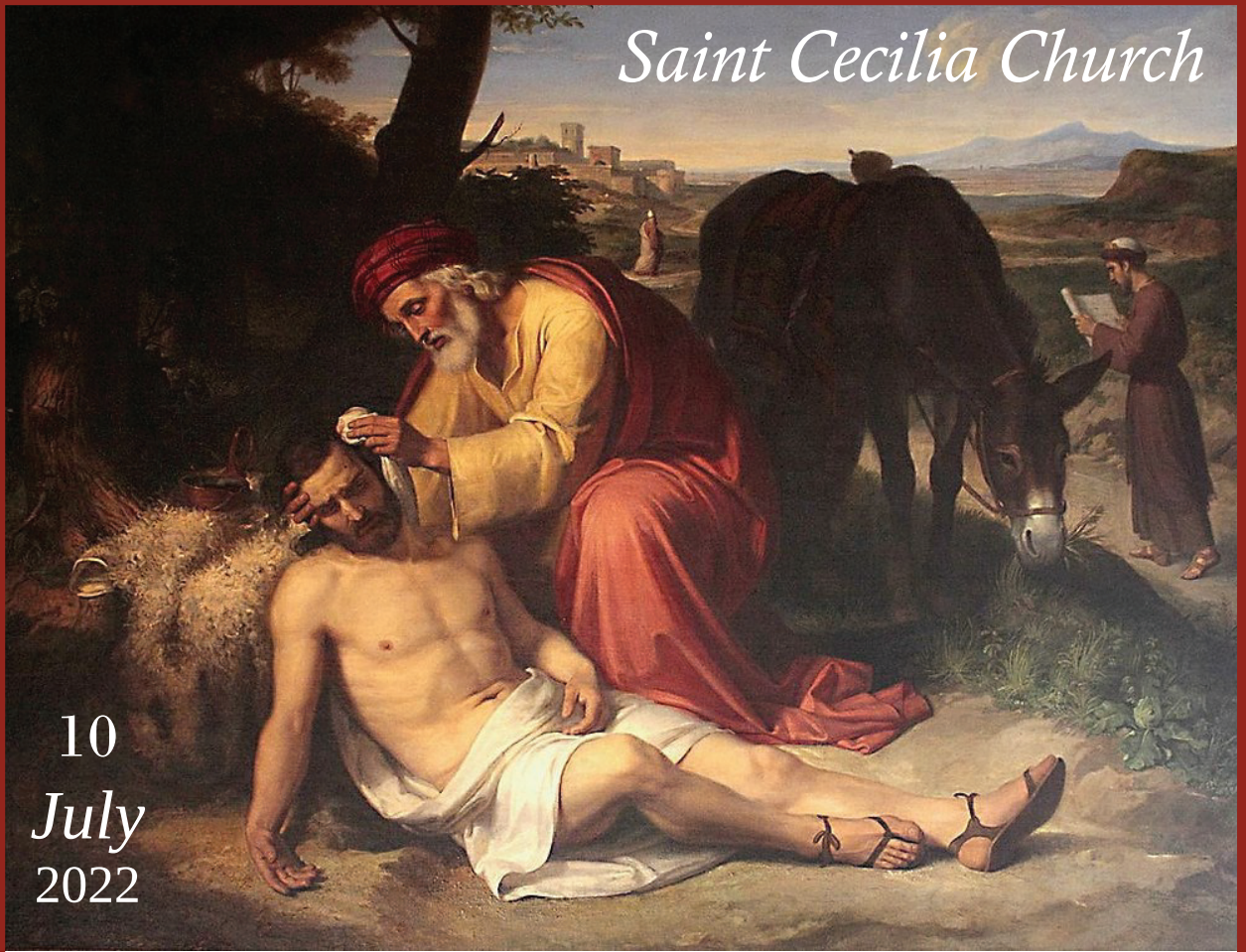

15TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Love of God and love of neighbor are essential for the life of a believer.

Both the Old and New Testaments emphasize the centrality of loving God and our neighbor. In the first reading, we hear Moses stressing the importance of this in one of the final speeches of his life. In the Gospel, Jesus' parable of the Good Samaritan expands the understanding of "neighbor" to include those we might consider strangers or even enemies, and "love" modeled on his example of selflessness and sacrifice.

Reflection: The Samaritan would have known from his own experience what it felt like to be "beaten up" and left behind. His was a member of a despised group, an outsider to the religious and national thinking of the Jew. Which may have stirred him to respond to the victim by the side of the road. He knew what it was like to be victimized.

So we ask ourselves:

- ◆ Can we remember an experience of being left out, treated as an outsider?
- ◆ Does that experience make us more aware and sensitive to the plight of outsiders these days? Who are these outsiders?

A baptized non-Catholic Christian may be chosen as a "Christian Witness," provided there is a Catholic godparent. A former Catholic may not serve as either a godparent or Christian Witness.

Arrangements must be made at least six (6) months in advance. Call the Rectory for an appointment. All scheduling considerations, including the initial date selection and any alterations, must be discussed with a Priest.

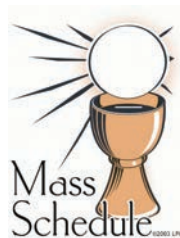

Sing a New Song

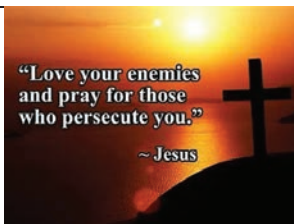

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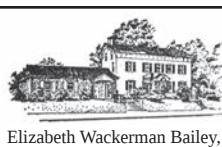


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
