PASTOR'S LETTER

Dear Friends,

I want to continue to share the results of our Parish's Next Generation Parish Envisioning Team. Remember, the Team was assembled in response to the Disciple Maker Index (DMI) that was done in Lent 2022. Last week I shared with our first priority of Family Engagement. Today, I share the proposed Parish Priority #2: Spiritual Growth in the life of parishioners.



Spiritual Growth is being defined as: St. Paul tells Christians: "Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will." (Romans 12, 2) Spiritual Growth is the process of developing an identity in Christ through a life of prayer and virtue that moves a person toward holiness and away from sin.

The rationale for having this as one of our three priorities is: Our parish values being faithful (entrusting oneself to God and all that He has revealed). The results of the Disciple Maker Index and our Focus Groups reveal a great desire to grow spiritually and know Jesus Christ in a deeply personal and intentional way. In the DMI, 33% of those responding want spiritual growth and 26% of the respondents did not identify Jesus "as a friend"; thus, we will create goals to help the entire parish grow spiritually in the next three years.



The Mass Explained ~ Year of the Eucharist: Understanding the Mass Part 8

The Confiteor - You wash your hands before you eat dinner, and you take off your dirty shoes when you walk into someone's house, don't you? The book of Proverbs tells us that "Even the just man sins seven times a day" (Proverbs 24:16). That's why we need to confess our sins at the beginning of Mass, and we do that in the Confiteor. It is deeply powerful, sincere, searching, and human. We begin by stating, "I confess to Almighty God and to you my brothers and sisters that I have sinned ..." That prayer screams "I am NOTHING! Please help me God! And everyone else help me too!" We pray it – we exclaim it! – at the beginning of Mass to prepare ourselves for what is about to take place, much as a humble and respectful guest removes his dirty shoes when he enters someone's beautiful home.

This brief teaching is part of a series as we seek to grow in understanding the Mass throughout the Year of the Eucharist.
