

NEW PARISHIONERS ~ Call the Rectory at 215-725-1240 for an appointment to register.

MOVING ~ Please notify the Rectory with any changes to your home address or when household members move to another residence.

BAPTISM ~ Every Sunday at 12:15pm. Arrangements must be made at least two weeks prior to the Baptism. Attendance at a Pre-Jordan class is required for first time parents and the godparents are also welcome. Please register for class by contacting the Rectory at 215-725-1240. The selected godparents must be fully initiated Roman Catholics, in good standing with the Church, and at least 16 years old. A baptized non-Catholic Christian may be chosen as a "Christian Witness," provided there is a Catholic godparent. A former Catholic may not serve as either a godparent or Christian Witness.

MARRIAGE ~ Arrangements must be made at least six months in advance. Call the Rectory for an appointment. All scheduling considerations, including the initial date selection and any alterations, must be discussed with a Priest.

RECONCILIATION ~ Mondays (6pm-7pm); Wednesdays (7am-8am); Saturdays (4pm-4:50pm)

HOMEBOUND VISITATION ~ Please contact the Rectory.

Dear Friends,

I am grateful for the feedback I have received on the Three Priority Areas of our Next Generation Pastoral Plan (Family Engagement, Spiritual Growth, Service and Outreach). I am also grateful to those who have volunteered to serve on the Implementation Team that will lead our Parish in reaching the goals that have been set. So, we will be guided by: *Transforming lives through faith inspired relationships.*

How you commit to "faith inspire relationships" so that more and more lives will be transformed! After all, that is why we are here!


In Remembrance


