NEW PARISHIONERS ~ Call the Rectory at 215-725-1240 for an appointment to register.

MOVING ~ Please notify the Rectory with any changes to your home address or when household members move to another residence.

BAPTISM ~ Every Sunday at 12:15pm. Arrangements must be made at least two weeks prior to the Baptism. Attendance at a Pre-Jordan class is required for first time parents and the godparents are also welcome. Please register for class by contacting the Rectory at 215-725-1240. The selected godparents must be fully initiated Roman Catholics, in good standing with the Church, and at least 16 years old. A baptized non-Catholic Christian may be chosen as a "Christian Witness," provided there is a Catholic godparent. A former Catholic may not serve as either a godparent or Christian Witness.

MARRIAGE ~ Arrangements must be made at least six months in advance. Call the Rectory for an appointment. All scheduling considerations, including the initial date selection and any alterations, must be discussed with a Priest.

RECONCILIATION ~ Mondays (6pm-7pm); Wednesdays (7am-8am); Saturdays (4pm-4:50pm)

Living Christ Today

If we have found the beauty of weekly Mass attendance in our own lives, a very natural question arises about our loved ones who do not come to Mass regularly. This theology of the Mass above affords us the occasion to talk about how we bring them with us whenever we come to Mass. Because of our unique role as the Body of Christ in the world, we have a priestly role to play. We offer sacrifice on the world's behalf. We mediate between God and the world. We intercede for those whom we represent at Mass. This truth means that while we can always invite and propose the Mass to others and witness to what the Mass has done for us, we can also lean into the fact that when we go to Mass, we bring those we think of with us. We can intercede for them.

As you walk through your day, try and collect all the people that you meet so that you can bring them with you (at least spiritually) to Mass.

At Mass, bring with you all your stuff: sorrows, joys, failures, and successes. Bring your children, your parents, your living and your dead, and know that when you are at Mass, through the priestly role you play on their behalf, God will bless them. Most people will never know in this life the good your intercession will have obtained from God for them, but in the next life, God willing, they will!

The Year of the Eucharist

Understanding the Mass - Part 10

Kyrie Eleison is Greek for “Lord, have mercy.” After we confess our sins at the start of Mass, we then beg God for mercy. The opening scene of the 1963 film “Lord of the Flies” shows British prep school boys in uniform marching in formation on the beach of a South Pacific island as they cheerfully sing their upbeat version of “Kyrie Eleison!” By the end of the movie, they are behaving like savages: no uniforms, no marching in formation, no singing, for their teachers had been killed in the plane crash and only the boys survived. The movie is a metaphor for the effects of Original sin, and what the human race would be like without our divine Savior. When we honestly come to grips with the reality of our situation - fallen human nature as a result of Original sin - how can we fail to cry out, “Lord, have mercy!”




